Narrative:

On the morning of September 10, 2024, at the request of the Columbus Division of Police, members of the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Investigations and Crime Scene units responded to an Officer-Involved Critical Incident at the Columbus Police Precinct 4 substation, located at 248 E. 11th Avenue, Columbus, Ohio 43201. It was reported that at approximately 0130 hours on this date, officers engaged a male who was armed with a meat cleaver and knife in the back parking lot of the substation. The male subject, identified as Lamine Mahmoudi (Mahmoudi), of 235 Chittenden Avenue, Columbus, died from injuries sustained during the confrontation.

Five of the six involved officers reportedly discharged their handguns, and one deployed a

Taser during the confrontation. No officers were injured during the incident. Video footage of the incident was captured on the officers' body-worn cameras.

Police responded to Mahmoudi's residence twice on the evening of September 9, 2024, on reports/complaints that Mahmoudi possibly cut himself with a knife, and that he barricaded himself within his home. The Columbus Police Mobile Crisis Response Unit (MCR) arrived on the second call, but Mahmoudi reportedly refused help.

It was unknown at the time whether or not any of the involved officers responded to the earlier calls.

Dispatch records and body-worn camera footage will be among the items reviewed as part of this investigation.
