Narrative:

On Saturday, October 5, 2024, at approximately 2345 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Joseph Goudy (Goudy) responded to the Medina County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) to meet with the involved deputies. The meeting was regarding the officer involved shooting that occurred in the 10300 block of Silvercreek Road, Doylestown, Ohio.

Upon arrival, SA Goudy spoke with the MCSO Ohio Patrolman's Benevolent Association (OPBA) union representative, Detective Jason Seiberling (Seiberling). Detective Sieberling identified the deputies as _______ and _______ and ______ Detective Sieberling said that the deputies will not provide a statement until they have their union attorney present.

After speaking briefly with the OPBA representative, SA Goudy met with and During the interactions, they were initially placed in separate rooms. While speaking with the deputies, it was discovered that their firearms were left behind at the scene secured until the BCI Crime Scene Unit obtained possession of them. It was determined that the deputies did not conduct a magazine change during the incident. The magazines were not taken; however, photos were taken of the magazines. Each magazine contained 17 rounds of 9mm ammunition. Both deputies had two extra magazines with them at the time of the incident. In addition, photos were taken of the deputies while they were wearing the same uniform and equipment from the incident.

The deputies, along with Detective Seiberling, were advised that the OPBA attorney, George Gerken will be contacted to schedule interviews.
