Narrative:

On Thursday, August 26, 2021, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Joseph Goudy (Goudy) received the medical records for Jaron Von Ginn (Ginn). The records were downloaded onto a DVD containing a secured password to review them by Diana Rinehart of OhioHealth-Mansfield Hospital records department. The records were obtained pursuant to a court order.

SA Goudy reviewed the medical records and noted the following:

Ginn's medical records consisted of 518 pages.

Pages 1-2 – Contains general patient information.

Pages 2-6 – Contains events, reason for visit, active medications on file, treatment team information and hospital Emergency Department (ED) attending notes. The records indicated that Ginn was admitted on 7/29/21, at 1758 hours for multiple stab wounds and discharged on 8/12/21, at 1645 hours.

Pages 7-13 – Contains treatment team, patient history, physical exam and lab results.

Pages 14-19 – Contains ED consultation notes.

Page 20 – Contains the "Attestation signed by Dr. Alexander Chapman on 7/29/21, at 2217 hours.

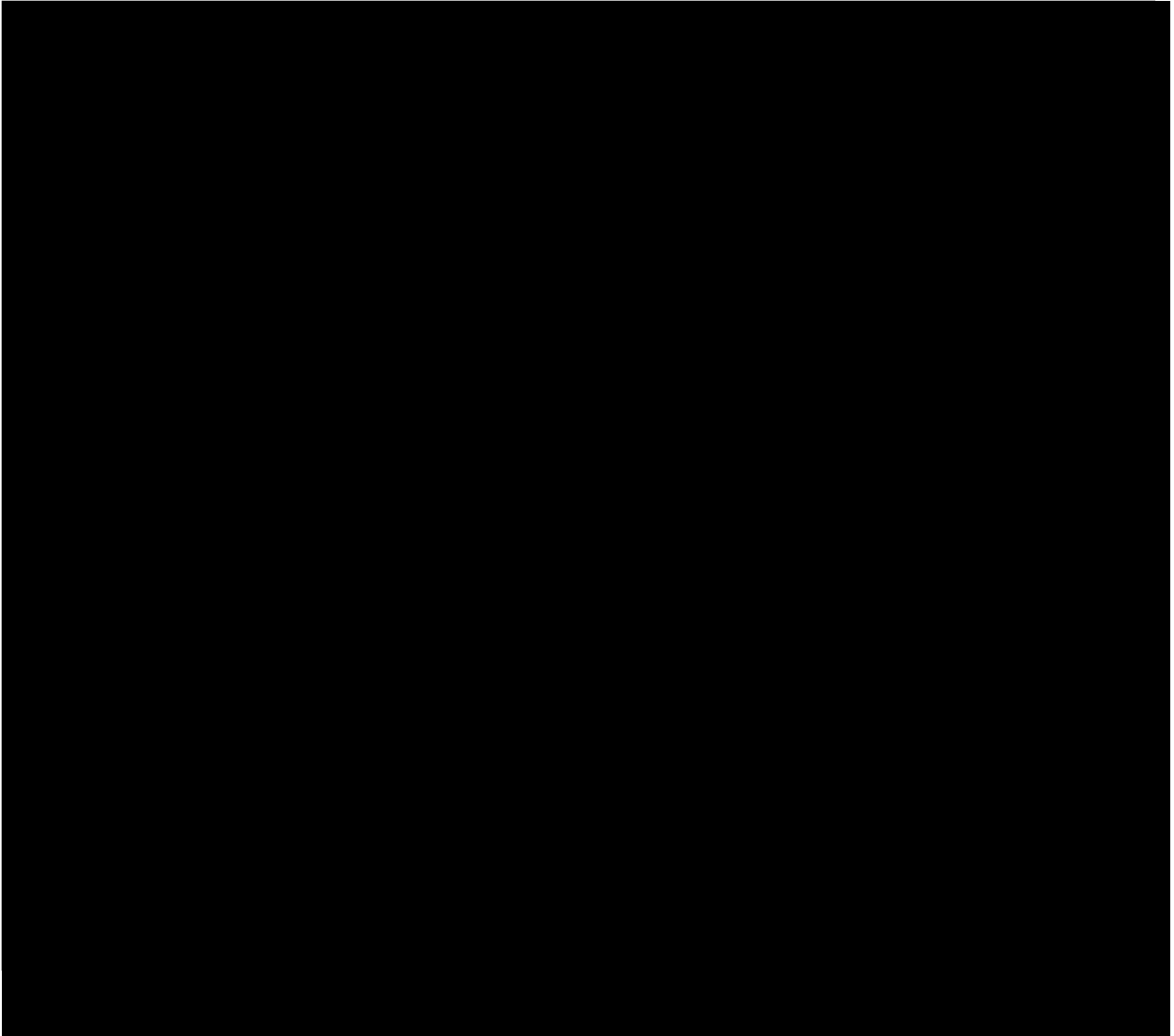


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Pages 21-32 – Contains the ED assessment and plan for treatment, mechanism for injury and history of present injury, past medical history and medications.

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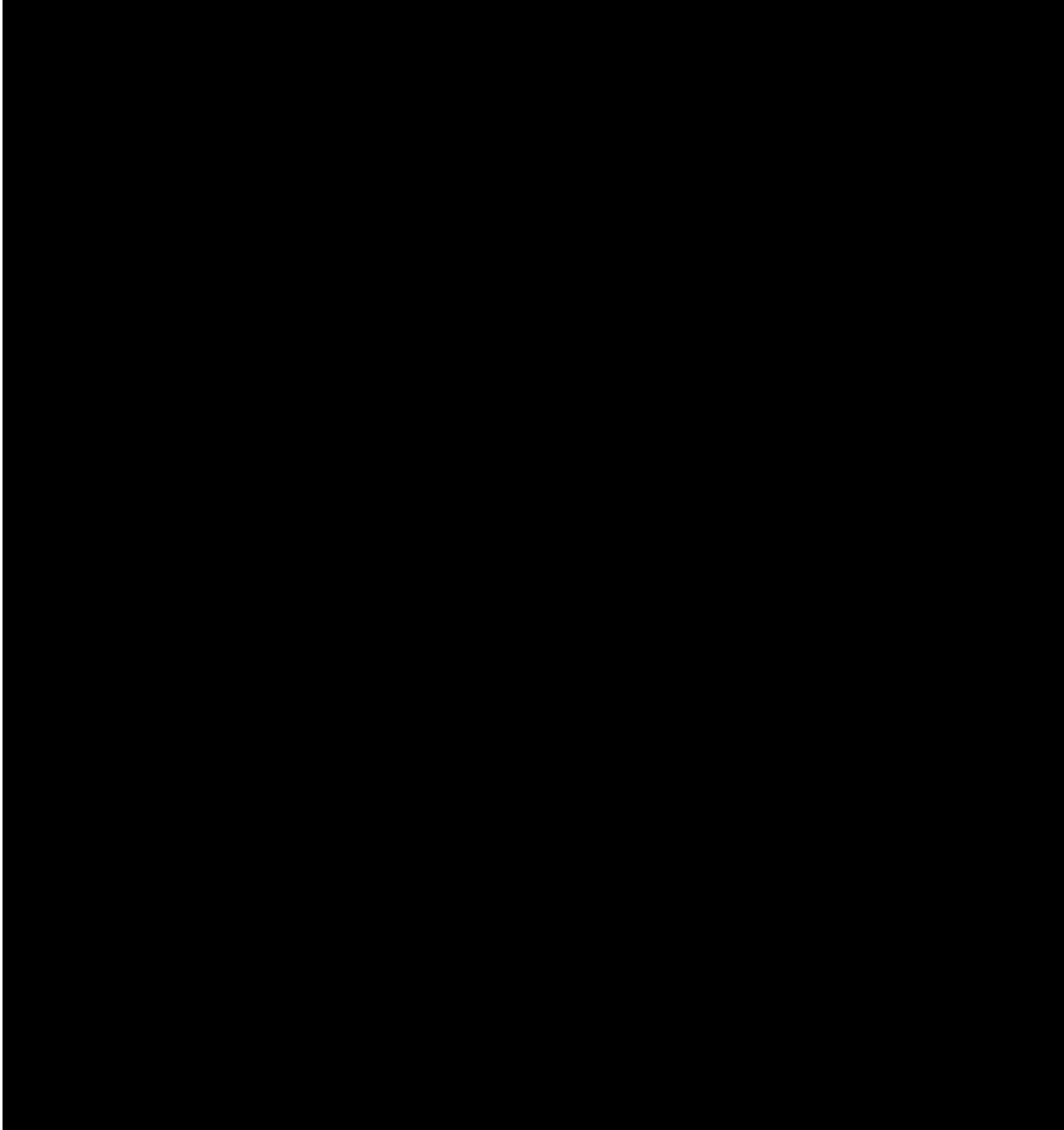
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Pages 33-35 – Contains photos of stab wounds, treatment and discharge information



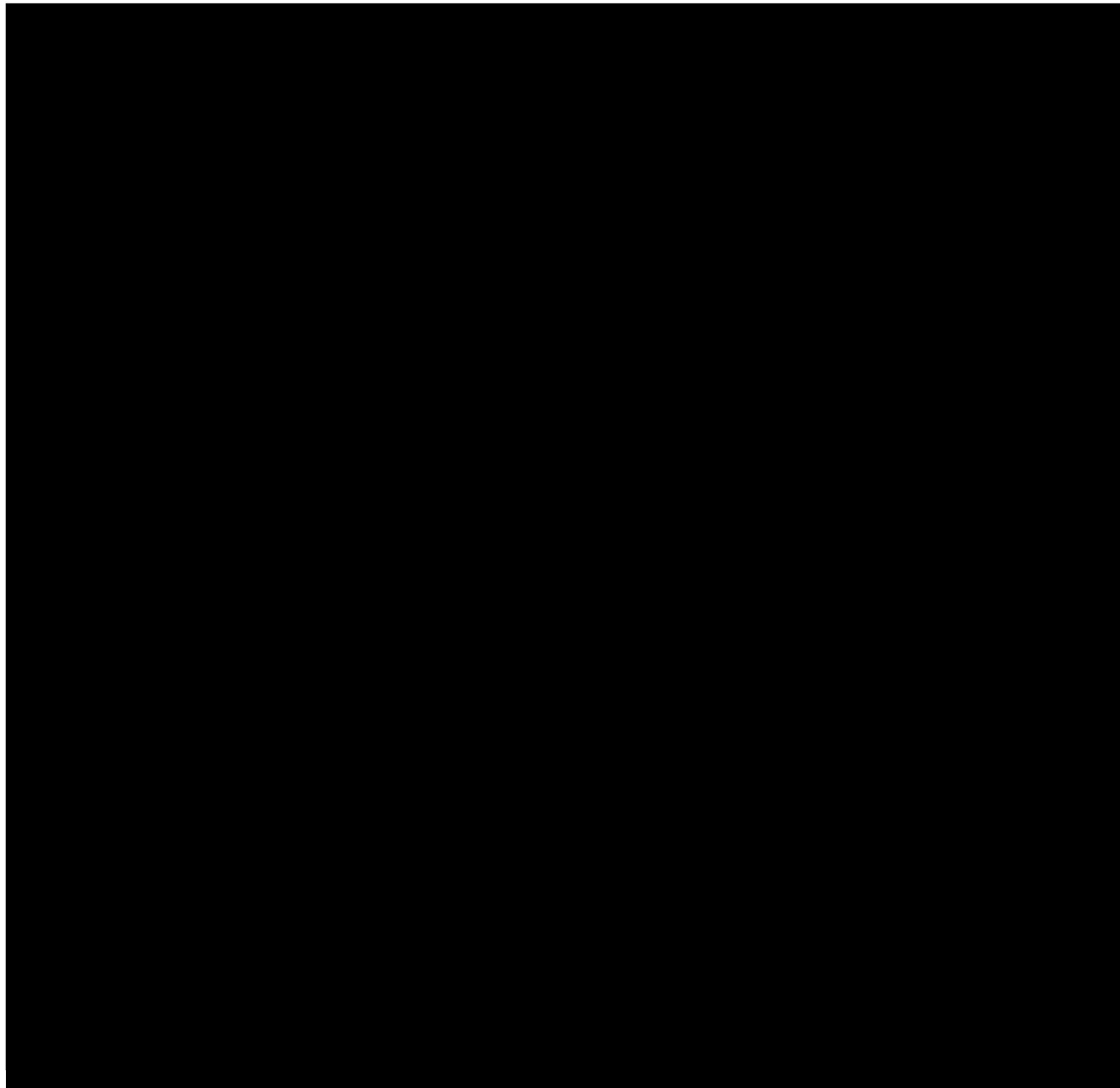


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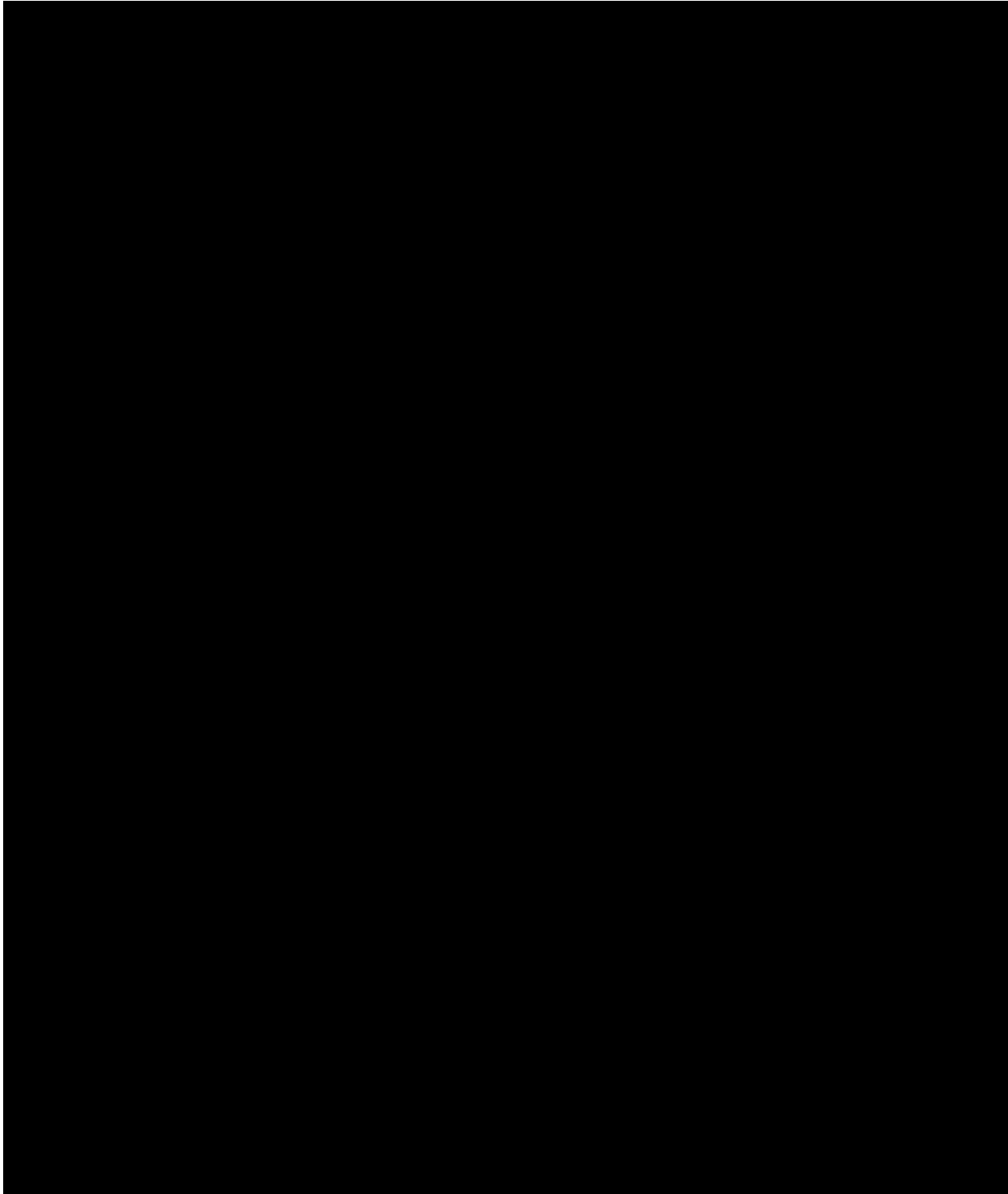


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Pages 36-129 – Contains follow-up to wound treatment and care, along with physical therapy treatment and occupational therapy treatment. In addition, it also contains nutrition care assessment.

Pages 130-135 – Contains discharge summary, notes and medications along with additional follow-up procedures.

Pages 136-225 – Contains labs, imaging, respiratory and anesthesia results and findings.

Pages 226-313 – Contains surgery information, event tracking and medications administered throughout the process.

Pages 314-319 – Contains other additional orders and consults.

Pages 319-458 – Contains medications along with additional evaluations and patient education.

Pages 459-518 – Contains after visit summary attachments, telemetry documentation, consent documentation.

The medical records obtained for this report are contained in the physical case file and are included in the BCI case file as item #61. Please refer to item #61 for further details.
