Narrative:

On Sunday, October 26, 2025, at 2107 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Carrie Ryan (SA Ryan) met with Ross County Sheriff's Office (RCSO) Deputy [REDACTED] who was accompanied by his attorney, Michael Moses, from the Teamsters. The meeting took place at: 28 N. Paint Street, Chillicothe, Ohio. The meeting was relative to an officer-involved critical incident which took place on Sunday October 26, 2025. [REDACTED] was identified as one (1) of the two (2) deputies who were involved in the shooting.

SA Ryan took photographs of [REDACTED] from four (4) angles. Additionally, SA Ryan took possession of the firearm (Sig Sauer P320 9 MM firearm, SN # [REDACTED] and one (1) magazine with remaining ammunition, used by [REDACTED] in the shooting. The firearm had a magazine with sixteen (16) remaining rounds and one (1) in the chamber. The second magazine (just photographed) was full with seventeen (17) rounds. There was a spot for a third magazine on [REDACTED] gun belt; however, that magazine was not present.

Additionally, SA Ryan learned [REDACTED] discharged his Taser (Taser 7; SN - [REDACTED] Taser cartridge was taken as evidence.

The firearm and Taser cartridge was later released to BCI crime scene agents.
