Narrative:

Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Cory Momchilov (Momchilov) received the Ohio BCI Laboratory firearm results on the previously submitted items. SA Momchilov reviewed and compared the results with statements, photographs and other evidence. SA Momchilov concluded the following information:

Summary

The fired cartridge case that was located on the Route 8 south entrance ramp, near where it was reported that Jayland Walker (Walker) had fired a shot, returned to the firearm that was located in Walker's vehicle. An additional fired cartridge case was located in Walker's vehicle. That fired cartridge case also returned to the firearm that was located in Walker's vehicle.

A total of 94 fired cases were located at the scene of the shooting. Based on the firearm laboratory report, officer statements and other physical evidence, the following conclusion was made:

Projectiles

No recovered projectiles conclusively returned to Officer [REDACTED] s firearm.

*It should be noted that Officer [REDACTED] stated that he was carrying a total of 24 rounds in his firearm, 23 in the extended magazine and 1 in the chamber. If Officer [REDACTED] was carrying 24 rounds, 7 rounds are missing from his firearm. Only six fired cartridge cases returning to Officer [REDACTED] s firearm was recovered at the scene.

Due to the discrepancy, SA Momchilov examined the extended magazine that Officer [REDACTED] was carrying in his firearm. SA Momchilov discovered that twenty-two 9mm rounds could easily be placed in the magazine. Using extreme force, SA Momchilov was able to place the 23rd round in the magazine.

The round count indicator on Officer [REDACTED] s extended magazine only goes to 17. It is possible that Officer [REDACTED] thought he was carrying 23 rounds in his magazine, when in fact, he was only carrying 22, which would account for only 6 fired cartridge cases being recovered.

Remarks

Four (4) BCI supplied cartridges were used for testing Item #99. One (1) of the cartridge cases was entered and searched in the NIBIN database. If investigative information becomes available, your agency will be notified.

Four (4) of the submitted cartridges per item from Items #147 – 154 were used for testing. Test fired specimens from a law enforcement officer’s duty weapon are not entered into the NIBIN database.

Cloth fibers were recovered from the fired bullets in Items #1, 6, 116, 138, 139, 140, and 145. The fibers were not examined. They were sub-exhibited and are being returned with the evidence.

There were no pertinent findings with regard to the submitted cartridges from Item #99.

All evidence will be returned to the submitting agency.
