Narrative:

On Sunday, May 12, 2024, the Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Investigations Unit and Crime Scene Unit were requested by the Columbus Police Department (CPD) to respond to Georgesville Road and Clime Road, Columbus, Ohio, in reference to an Officer-Involved Critical Incident (OICI). Please see the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between CPD and BCI. Responding from BCI were Special Agents James Poole, Chad Holcomb, Ryan Scheiderer, and David Wieging. From BCI Crime Scene responding Agents were Mathew Austin, Aja Chung, Sarah Taylor, and Crime Scene Technicians Holly Ryczek and Amy Gill. Also responding was acting Supervisor Jim Mulford.

The critical incident involved a subject, Hamsa Yusuf Ali (Yusuf), and Columbus Police Officers [REDACTED], Franklin Township Officers [REDACTED]. Also involved were Madison County Deputies [REDACTED].

SA Poole spoke with CPD Sergeant Terry McConnell (Sergeant McConnell), who explained CPD was responding to an officer assistance call from Madison County Sheriff's deputies who were assigned to the Homeland Security Task Force. The deputies had located Yusuf driving a vehicle after he had engaged in a shooting in West Jefferson, Ohio, earlier that day. Multiple agencies had boxed in Yusuf's vehicle at the listed intersection where Yusuf exited the vehicle and began firing at officers. Multiple officers returned fire resulting in Yusuf being transported to the hospital where he ultimately succumbed to his injuries.
