Narrative:

On Wednesday, December 03, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Joe Lamping (SA Lamping) compiled background information on John Adams (Adams), a subject involved in the incident on November 14, 2025. The information included researching past police reports involving the subject, searching criminal history records, open/closed-source database inquiries, and social media posts. The information gathered was obtained from the BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit and the Trumbull County Sheriff's Office (TCSO).

SA Lamping reviewed the information and noted the following:

Prior Interactions with the Trumbull County Sheriff's Office

The TCSO provided two incident reports involving Adams. The most recent report was filed on November 14, 2025, at 1846 hours. The report was written by Deputy Gary Musilino and explained that Adams had called into the TCSO jail at approximately 1500 hours. During the call, he requested that an officer notify Mackenzie Royer (Royer) to call him. When Royer was notified that Adams wished for her to call him, she informed the deputy that she would not call him as he was the reason she was incarcerated and alleged that Adams was harassing her family.

The second report was from an incident that occurred on February 28, 2025. The report was filed by [REDACTED] and detailed an investigation into the theft of Adams' motor vehicle. During the incident Royer was arrested for the theft of Adams' vehicle and possession of narcotics.

Adams was not a suspect in either of the prior reports obtained from the TCSO.

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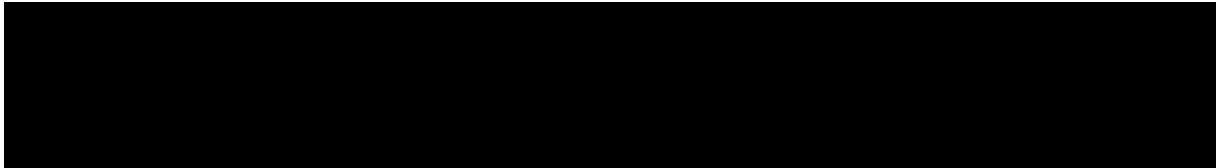


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Social Media Posts Related to Adams

Though no social media accounts belonging to Adams were located, two posts pertaining to Adams were found. The first post was an obituary for Adams' daughter, Ashley Adams, who passed away on December 3, 2020. The obituary included a section with various posts related to Ashley Adams, some of which were messages, and some of which were photographs. It does not appear that Adams made any of the posts, nor did he appear in any of the photographs.

One Facebook photo posted by Adams' mother, Marguerite Adams, was also located. The photo showed Adams, Ashley Adams, and Marguerite Adams together.

The documents received relative to Adams are attached to this report for further review, except for any prohibited LEADS/CCH reports which were disposed of according to applicable policies and procedures.
