lessees therein named. I further find, upon examination of the leases and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with Section 471, General Code, under the authority of which these leases are executed, and with other statutory enactments relating to leases of this kind.

I am, accordingly, approving the leases above mentioned as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed thereon and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies of each of these leases, all of which are herewith returned to you.
