DEAR SIR:—You have submitted for my approval contract between the State of Ohio, acting by the Department of Highways and Public Works, and the Combustion Engineering Corporation at 43 Broadway, New York City, New York. This contract covers the construction and completion of two Underfeed Stokers for Ohio University at Athens and calls for an expenditure of \$5,850.00.

You have submitted the certificate of the Director of Finance to the effect that there are unencumbered balances legally appropriated in a sum sufficient to cover the obligations of the contract.
