Narrative:

On May 20, 2022, Special Agents Doug Eveslage and Kenneth Smith with the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation responded to an Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) that occurred at 947 Business State Route 28, Milford, Clermont County, Ohio, involving the Miami Township Police Department and Camille Weems. SA's Eveslage and Smith interviewed Kelly Horton (Horton) about witnessing the OICI in the parking lot of her apartment complex.

Horton stated that she was in her apartment with the window open when she heard gunfire in the parking lot. She recalls opening her window more, looking outside and seeing the Miami Township police officers giving these commands, "Get down, roll over, or get down." SA Eveslage asked if Horton saw any of the critical incident, and Horton stated, "I did not see anything, I heard the shots and by the time I got down the steps, I want to say it seemed like she was still moving a little bit." SA Eveslage asked Horton if she heard any commands before the shots were fired, and Horton answered, "No."

SA Eveslage asked Horton if she saw any weapons Weems had, and Horton answered, "No." SA Eveslage asked Horton how many shots she heard, and Horton stated, "six to eight." SA Eveslage mentioned the first aid equipment laying on the ground and asked Horton if she saw anything related to first aid being preformed, but Horton advised no because she did not have her glasses on and does not see distances well.

This interview was concluded at approximately 1941 hours. The interview was audio recorded. See attachment #01 for further details.
