### Narrative:

On the afternoon of December 30, 2020, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) James Gore and Special Agent Supervisor (SAS) Kevin Barbeau interviewed Upper Arlington Fire Paramedic Kenneth Packard at Upper Arlington Fire Station 72, 3861 Reed Road, Upper Arlington, OH 43220. Also present was the Upper Arlington City Attorney, Darren Shulman. The purpose of the interview was to have the paramedic describe his involvement and response to the officer involved critical incident which occurred on the morning of December 22, 2020, at 1062 Oberlin Drive in Columbus.

Mr. Packard stated that in addition to the emergency medical response from Upper Arlington, a second ambulance from the Columbus Fire Department, Medic 19, was dispatched, and it was a two-person unit. Packard said he did not know the names of the Columbus medics and he has not worked with them previously. Packard stated that he was working an that morning.

Packard mentioned that they were dispatched to the neighboring community on Oberlin as part of an "automatic" or mutual aid agreement with Columbus. Likewise, he said, Columbus medics and fire are often dispatched to Upper Arlington's jurisdiction.

Packard explained that he was the driver of the ambulance, and his partner, Paul Hill, was the lead paramedic for that shift. Packard later mentioned that Captain Don Ingersoll responded, but he drove separately. Packard said the route they took to the scene was south on Reed Road, east on Fishinger Road, north on Kenny Road, then east onto Oberlin Drive.

Packard said he saw an abundance of police vehicles in the area when his unit arrived, and he recalled being guided in to the scene by officers on the ground. Packard recalled that a few police cars were being moved to accommodate the arrival of the ambulance, but it was a

straight route from Kenny Road to the residence on Oberlin. According to Packard, their unit was the first ambulance on scene.

Packard stated that he parked the ambulance at the end of the driveway of the residence (1062 Oberlin). Packard said he observed that a police officer was doing CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation) on the victim on the ground. Packard stated that they got out of the ambulance, grabbed the EKG (electrocardiogram) machine, and approached the victim (Andre Hill). Packard later mentioned that he heard an officer tell Paul, 'Police involved shooting.'

Packard mentioned that Paul told the police officer to continue doing CPR while he gathered information. He later clarified that CPR was paused only momentarily while he applied the EKG patches and checked for a heart rhythm. According to Packard, the officer reported that he had been doing CPR for a few minutes prior to their arrival. Packard said the victim's heart rhythm was asystole, which meant that there was no electrical activity or pulse. Packard further explained that no cardiac medications were administered because the victim was in asystole. He said the police wanted the victim to be transported to the hospital. He further recalled that as he was retrieving equipment from his ambulance, Medic 19 from Columbus arrived on scene.

Packard recalled that the victim's hands were cuffed behind his back at the time, so he requested that an officer uncuff him so that he could be placed on the transport cot. Packard recalled seeing a small hole on the victim's upper right chest, but he did not observe an exit wound when they rolled the victim over. He said he didn't observe any other wounds, but he was later told at the hospital that there were additional ones.

Mr. Packard said that none of the wounds were treated by himself or the Medic 19 crew at the time because the wounds were not actively bleeding (due to asystole). Packard said they transported the victim to Riverside Hospital, and he later explained that two Columbus medics, along with a police officer, rode in the back of the ambulance to the hospital.

Packard was asked to describe what he recalled from the dispatch call his unit received. He said it was to meet the police on a shooting. According to Mr. Packard, Upper Arlington uses the multi-jurisdictional dispatch center in Dublin. Packard explained that the ambulance automatically transmits departure and arrival times through its computer and geo-location systems. He said he reviewed the run reports, which indicated that it only took three minutes to arrive at the location on Oberlin. He estimated, however, that it only took approximately two minutes to arrive, with an additional 30 seconds or so on Oberlin because of the congestion with police vehicles.

Packard explained again that CPR was only paused momentarily while he checked for the heart rhythm with the EKG. One other officer, he said, switched with the initial officer, but other than that, CPR never stopped until they arrived at the hospital. Packard further explained that prior to transporting the victim, they applied a device called an AutoPulse™, which is an automatic, mechanical CPR machine. The device performed chest compressions for the duration of the transport. 


Packard said when the ambulance arrived at Riverside Hospital Emergency Department, they took him into the first trauma bay. Packard said he believed that when they moved the victim's body over (to the care of the Emergency Department), the doctor "called it right there," (declared deceased). Mr. Packard said he did not know the name of the hospital physician.

Packard was asked to describe what he remembered about the position of the victim's body when his unit arrived at the scene on Oberlin. Packard explained that the victim's torso was positioned in a manner in which his head was lying outside of the garage, but his legs/feet were inside. He recalled seeing a cellphone on the ground when they lifted the victim's body. Packard said he remembered someone asking about it, and he recalled someone else (an officer) say, 'Just leave it.' Mr. Packard said they did not locate any identification on the victim,

and he remained unidentified for the duration of the medic run.

Packard was then asked to describe the route he took to Riverside Hospital. He mentioned that he backed the ambulance up from the scene and turned around, adding that he couldn't drive forward (east) toward Shattuck Avenue because of the police vehicles. He also mentioned that the Medic 19 crew told him that their arrival was delayed by police vehicles, because they came in on Shattuck. (*Note: the map depicted below is for reference only.*)



Mr. Packard reported that he has been with the Upper Arlington Division of Fire for 27 years and he finished his paramedic training at Columbus State Community College in 1993. Packard also said he receives a minimum of 280 hours of continuing training every three years on a variety of job-related skills and tasks.

Packard agreed that the times were accurate with the exception of the 02:06 "At patient" time. He explained that they were actually at the patient sooner, but their system doesn't permit the time to be the same as the arrival time, so typically the next minute is entered. He also explained that the "Dispatch," "En route," and "At scene" times were automatically input by the system, but the "Transport" and "At dest." times were manually annotated by him when he pressed a button on the ambulance's computer console.

Upon further review of the Patient Care Report, Packard explained that it indicated that

Paul Hill, according to Packard, completed the report.
