**Narrative:**

On Wednesday, October 23, 2024, at approximately 1030 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent John Tingley (SA Tingley) reviewed the 911 Call audio recording related to the officer involved critical incident which occurred on August 17, 2024, in the area of 2215 East Avenue, Akron, Summit County, Ohio.

The following is a synopsis of the audio recording and is not a word for word translation of the conversation between the caller and the 911 operator. For further details, please review the audio recording in its entirety.

The audio recording was 0:01:31 in length. However, there is no time stamp on the audio recording.

The male caller stated that at the gas station on East Avenue in Akron, he observed a U-Haul truck recklessly exit the parking lot of the gas station with an Akron Police Officer holding on to the front door of the U-Haul. The caller also stated that he heard gunshots. However, the caller was unable to give a description of the subject driving the U-Haul.

When asked by the 911 operator for his name, the caller replied "Mo".
