Narrative:

On November 18, 2025 Special Agent Brady Curry (SA) conducted interviews with Firefighter/Paramedics at Union Township Fire Department Station 49 located at 718 Old State Route 74, Cincinnati, OH. This interview was documented through use of SA Curry's Body Worn Camera (BWC).

Present for the interview were the following; each responded to provide medical aid to Thomas Noble after he sustained a gunshot wound(s).

Firefighter/Medics were asked to stage in the area of Cider Mill. Assistant Chief Terrel Responded from his residence.

Medics were radioed to proceed into the scene. CPR was in progress when they arrived. Medics advised no signs of life were present during their assessment. Medics advised they rendered aid following proper protocols.

The medics did not ask and were not told details regarding the incident. They were just advised of the gun shot wound.

The medics did not see any weapons around Noble upon their arrival.

Noble was loaded into the ambulance and transported to the hospital.

Assistant Chief Terrel advised Noble's mother was in need of medical attention. Station 50
