APPROVAL—GRANTS OF EASEMENT, STATE OF OHIO, THROUGH CONSERVATION COMMISSIONER, FIVE TRACTS OF LAND, GRANTORS NUMBERED AND DESIGNATED, VIOLET TOWNSHIP, FAIRFIELD COUNTY, OHIO, FOR PUBLIC FISHING GROUNDS AND TO IMPROVE THE WATER OR WATER COURSES PASSING THROUGH AND OVER SAID LAND.
