Narrative:

On August 24, 2023 at 2024 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent James Poole (SA Poole) interviewed Kroger employee Jaylyn Young (Jaylyn). The interview took place at the Kroger on 5991 Sunbury Rd., Westerville, Ohio. Jaylyn was identified as being a witness who potentially witnessed the officer involved shooting that occurred in the parking lot which involved the now deceased Ta'kiya Young (Ta'kiya). The purpose of the interview was to obtain all relevant information of the incident known or observed by this individual.

This interview was audio recorded and a copy of the recording was saved electronically within the case file. Please refer to the recording for specific quotes. The following is a summation of the interview.

Before interviewing Jaylyn, Franklin County Deputy Clausing #1501, gave SA Poole a signed witnessing statement that was filled out by Jaylyn. Please see attached for more details to the written statement.

Jaylyn stated she was working overtime at the Kroger's front desk when she witnessed three (3) Black females walking funny out the front door, setting off the theft sensor sirens and lights. When asked how they looked funny, Jaylyn stated the females had duffle bags and purses that were overflowing with items and acted like they just stole things. Jaylyn also stated at that time another employee approached her stating the three (3) females stole alcohol from the liquor store inside Kroger.

Jaylyn stated from past experience of individuals stealing, she normally goes outside and tries to take a picture of the license plate as they leave to file a police report later. Jaylyn said as she followed them outside the three (3) females went separate ways. Jaylyn saw that one of the females, later identified as Ta'kiya Young (Ta'kiya), was getting into a black car close by.

While walking up to her vehicle Jaylyn saw two (2) Blendon Township Police (BTP) officers helping someone who was parked directly behind Ta'kiya. Jaylyn knew one of the officers from past thefts at Kroger and stated his name was Eric Moynihan (Officer Moynihan). Jaylyn explained to him the theft that just occurred. As Officer Moynihan approached the driver side door, Jaylyn stated she tried to take a picture of the rear license plate, but there was none.

Jaylyn heard Officer Moynihan command Ta'kiya out of the vehicle where she refused. Jaylyn stated Officer Moynihan confronted Ta'kiya about the theft and ordered her to come out. Jaylyn stated Ta'kiya still refused and began to start her vehicle. At this time the second BTP officer had positioned himself in front of Ta'kiya's vehicle on the driver side with his weapon out pointing downward. As Ta'kiya started her vehicle, Jaylyn explained the second BTP officer raised his weapon and pointed it at Ta'kiya commanding her to stop and get out. Jaylyn stated the officer commanded Ta'kiya to get out, "at least five (5) different times."

Jaylan stated at this point she did not want to see what was going to happen and turned to get away. Jaylyn then saw the back of Jaylyn's vehicle move forward and heard the roar of the engine. Jaylyn then heard one gunshot go off causing her to run back into the Kroger. Jaylyn explained how she ran directly inside and did not look back.

After a few minutes, Jaylyn stated she then looked out the front doors of Kroger to see what had happened and saw Ta'kiya's vehicle crashed into the side of the Kroger building with officers conducting CPR on Ta'kiya.

SA Poole asked if Jaylyn heard anymore gunshots after the first one. Jaylyn explained how she didn't and would have heard them, even still inside Kroger.

SA Poole asked if Jaylyn would be available for further questions in the future. Jaylyn stated yes and gave her information to SA Poole.

The interview concluded at 2043 hours.
