Narrative:

On May 30, 2022, Special Agent (SA) Tyler Price responded to an Officer Involved Critical Incident at 1551 Meadowlark Lane, Marysville, OH. Upon arriving at the location, SA Price began a neighborhood canvass for witnesses and digital evidence. Several residences around the location were checked for possible video footage, but no residence was located that had an operable camera recording at the time of the incident.

While canvassing the area, SA Price made contact with the homeowner at 582 Meadowlark Lane, Abby Gamby. Mrs. Gamby explained that she had arrived home at approximately 1841 hours and had passed the suspect truck in the street. She said that an unknown male was standing outside of the truck, with the door open, looking around in a manner she found to be odd. She said that she then pulled into her driveway and began unloading her vehicle.

While unloading her vehicle, Mrs. Gamby said that she heard yelling. She believed that she heard someone yelling, "Hands up" and "Get out." She stated that she walked down towards the end of the driveway to look back towards the truck and noticed a law enforcement vehicle behind the truck. She said that she then heard four or five loud pops, which caused her to run back into her house.

Mrs. Gamby said that she was not familiar with any of the neighbors that lived near the incident and that she did not recognize the suspect vehicle or the male who had been standing near it. She stated that she did not have any further information.
