On Monday, August 19, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) John Tingley (Tingley) obtained and reviewed background information on Michael Jones (Jones), the subject involved in the officer-involved critical incident at 2215 East Avenue, Akron, Summit County, Ohio. The information included: computerized criminal history (CCH) records, court records (if applicable), and open/closed source database inquiries. The information gathered was obtained from the BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit.
