Narrative:

On June 28, 2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Arvin Clar (Clar) attended and viewed the post-mortem examination/autopsy of Jayland Walker at the Summit County Medical Examiner's Office, located at 85 North Summit St., Akron, Ohio.

The autopsy began at 0920 hours and was conducted by Dr. Robert Shott (Shott). The autopsy was also attended and assisted by Robin Clemens (Autopsy Technician).

The Summit County Medical Examiner's case report number was identified as #22-2146.

Dr. Shott continued through the entire procedure to take photographs of all wounds, as well as the dissection of the body and focus photos of the injuries.

On June 29, 2022, SA Clar obtained the deceased's property from the Medical Examiner's Office, as well as evidence obtained at the autopsy, and conveyed the items to BCI. All items were placed into temporary evidence.

On July 5, 2022, SA Clar returned to the Summit County Medical Examiner's Office and retrieved an additional bullet that was later found in the upper-body cavity of the deceased.

This bullet was conveyed to BCI and placed into temporary evidence.
