Narrative:

On July 5, 2022, at approximately 1520 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Cory Momchilov requested that BCI SA Andrew Harasimchuk (Harasimchuk) follow up on a tip that was received related to the Akron Police Department officer-involved shooting that occurred on June 27, 2022. The tip stated the following:

"Information on Jayland Walker incident in Akron, Ohio . I was speaking with my mother whom had mutual friends in common with Jaylands girlfriend who was in the motor vehicle fatality out of state. His girlfriend was employed at the Akron Walmart (Springfield Twp). Jayland told people he couldn't live without her and would do anything he had to be with her. Jaylands family stated he was religious, if that is true his religion belief he couldn't commit suicide on his own and get to heaven. So suicide by cop should be looked into since he ran from two departments, and put his ring by the gun in the car. This information was given third party. But the person he told was Teresa Kish husband from Akron she works at Walmart in Akron also! Thanks"

BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit Analyst William Moskal identified Michael Kish (Kish) as being the husband of Teresa Kish in the above-mentioned tip.

On July 7, 2022, at approximately 1015 hours, SA Harasimchuk attempted to interview Kish at his residence located at 4689 Manchester Road, New Franklin, Ohio 44203. There was no response at the door. SA Harasimchuk left his business card, along with a BCI door hanger in the front door with a note asking Michael Kish to contact SA Harasimchuk.

On July 7, 2022, at approximately 1358 hours, SA Harasimchuk received a phone call from (330) 289-0377. The caller left SA Harasimchuk a voice message and identified himself as being Kish.

On July 7, 2022, at approximately 1600 hours, SA Harasimchuk returned Kish's phone call. SA Harasimchuk advised Kish as to why he was calling Kish. Kish stated that he was only familiar with this incident from hearing about it on the radio. When asked, Kish confirmed that he was

married to Teresa Kish (Teresa). Kish said that he lives in New Franklin and stated that he did not know Jayland Walker (Walker). SA Harasimchuk then asked Kish if Teresa knew Walker. Kish said that Teresa was not home but he did not believe that Teresa would know Walker. SA Harasimchuk asked Kish to have Teresa contact SA Haraismchuk.

On July 8, 2022, at approximately 1439 hours, SA Harasimchuk received a phone call from (330) 571-3452. The caller left a voice message identifying herself as Teresa.

On July 11, 2022, at approximately 1458 hours, SA Harasimchuk returned Teresa's phone call. SA Harasimchuk advised Teresa why he was calling her. Teresa stated that she was familiar with this incident from the media but also because Walker's fiancé worked with her. Teresa stated that she never had any interaction with Walker and never talked with Walker.

It should be noted that BCI SA Matthew Armstrong (Armstrong) reviewed Walker's phone calls, text messages and contacts. SA Armstrong did not locate either of the following phone numbers in Walker's phone calls, text messages and contacts: (330) 289-0377 and (330) 571-3452.
