Gentlemen:— An examination of the transcript for the above issue of bonds discloses that these bonds were advertised for sale in one newspaper, beginning on July 23, 1925, and in another, beginning on July 24, 1925, and giving notice of the sale of the bonds on August 17, 1925.

Section 3924, General Code, provides that such bonds shall be advertised for sale for four consecutive weeks in two newspapers of general circulation in the municipality.

In the case of Kuhner and King, 107 O. S., page 406, it has been held under a similar statute that the requirement for four consecutive weeks must necessarily be for the entire period thereof, that is for a period of time not less than twenty-eight days.

As these bonds have not been sold in compliance with the provisions of the statutes, I am compelled to disapprove the same, and you are advised not to accept said bonds.
