Narrative:

On Friday, January 23, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) John Tingley (SA Tingley) reviewed video footage from the Euclid Police Department (EPD). SA Tingley was informed that the videos contained footage from the dash cameras recorded by EPD [REDACTED] related to the OICI which occurred on January 11, 2026.

The listed narrative is a synopsis of the activities recorded on [REDACTED] cruiser dash camera video (Axon_Fleet_3_Front_Camera_Video_2026-01-11_2226.mp4) and only documents those activities which the author deems to be the most relevant to the OICI. Furthermore, the narrative does not cover all of the activities or radio traffic recorded. Nor is the synopsis a word for word translation of the radio traffic. It is suggested that the full recording be reviewed to clarify any content or contextual questions.

SA Tingley reviewed the video recordings and noted the following:

The video began on January 11, 2026, at 22:25:17 hours, is 02:42 in length and started with [REDACTED] sitting in his cruiser at an intersection. Initially there was no audio.

At approximately 22:26:16 hours, the audio is activated when [REDACTED] activated the overhead lights and siren on his cruiser when he began to travel towards 1451 East 219th Street, Euclid, Ohio.

At approximately 22:27:36 hours, EPD Dispatch notified officers that the male subject involved in the call for service was at 1451 East 219th, Euclid, while the female involved in the call for service was at 1481 East 219th Street, Euclid. Officers were also notified that there was a three (3) year old child at the residence with the male subject.

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At 22:28:00 hours, the video concluded as [REDACTED] arrived in the area of the call and turned off his overhead lights and siren.

The video did not show any part of the shooting incident.

It should also be noted that there was a duplicate of this video provided by EPD to BCI (Axon_Fleet_3_Front_Camera_Video_2026-01-11_2226.mp4). The duplicate video was checked and the date and time and length of the video were identical. Furthermore, the hash values of the video were also checked and were also identical. Therefore, there will not be a separate report documenting the duplicate video.

The dash camera video is attached to this case as Reference Item C which is stored in AXON JUSTICE.
