During the early morning hours of April 22, 2019, the Summit County Sheriff's Office received the type of call no one ever wants. A two year old was missing from his residence in the city of Green. Anytime a toddler is missing it is obviously a high priority precarious situation. When it is in the middle of the night and the toddler is autistic and non-verbal, as in this incident, the event becomes even more critical and difficult for the First Responders answering the call. In this case, to make matters even worse, the toddler lived in an area with various fields and close to the Nimisila Lake Reservoir (a large body of water area.)

After responding deputies confirmed the child was not anywhere in the residence, the call went out for support teams from whomever was available. We could have never imagined the type of response we received, as it was truly unbelievable. Within a short period of time we had well over one hundred first responders from various law enforcement and Fire/EMS agencies, several members of organizations trained in searches, and government employee support personnel in the area coordinating and searching for the missing toddler. Additional resources of mounted patrols (horseback), K-9s', ATVs', and air support (helicopter and drones) along with watercraft also arrived and were utilized. A reverse 9-1-1 call was electronically sent to all area residents advising them to check their property for the child as well. Needless to say, time was of the essence and having all of these people and resources was very comforting although all of us were fearing the worst. Luckily, approximately 5 hours into the incident, the toddler was found safe in a neighbor's car in their garage.

This was a huge group effort and we at the Summit County Sheriff's Office can never thank you, and everyone else who put forth such a team effort for the benefit of this little boy. We truly appreciate you assisting in this very critical situation and you certainly rose to the occasion when called upon! Again, we say thank you and please know we will never forget the response we received on this day!




