PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT, SUMMARY— SECTION 4785-175 G. C.—TO AMEND CONSTITUTION OF OHIO, ARTICLE III, SECTIONS 1, 2; ARTICLE IV, NEW SEC-TIONS 3a, 3b, 7a, 7b,; ADOPTING AND ADDING TO ARTICLE X ELEVEN NEW SECTIONS, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 AND 18—EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT—STATE OFFICERS—JUDIC-IARY—COUNTY OFFICERS.

You have submitted for my examination a written petition bearing over one hundred names, containing a proposed constitutional amendment and a summary of the same under Section 4785-175, General Code. It is proposed to amend the Constitution of the State of Ohio by changing two sections (i. e., Sections I and 2) of Article III; by adopting and adding to Article IV four new sections i. e., (Sections 3a, 3b, 7a and 7b); and by adopting and adding to Article X eleven new sections (i. e., Sections 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18).
