Narrative:

On Tuesday, September 20, 2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) John Tingley (Tingley) received an email from Lieutenant Feeney of the Knox County Sheriff's Office. The email correspondence consisted of the autopsy report from the Licking County Coroner's Office for Randy Wilhelm (Wilhelm).
