Narrative:

On Sunday, March 16, 2025, at 0513 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Eric Lehnhart (SA Lehnhart) interviewed Becky Lynn Clark (Clark), relative to the officer-involved critical incident which took place on Sunday, March 16, 2025. The interview took place at the Ravenna Police Department, 220 South Way, Ravenna, Ohio 44266. The purpose of the interview was to obtain all relevant information about the incident known or observed by this individual.

Clark stated that she had taken her medication for the evening and sat down in a recliner that was in her bedroom. She continued to state that the medication she was prescribed "pretty much knocks me out." When Clark retired to her room, she stated that Terrence "Terry" Conway (Conway) was the only person inside her apartment.

Clark said she was woken from her sleep when Conway began to yell towards her room. As Clark got up from her recliner, the Ravenna police were already at the door to her apartment. Clark stated that she had no recollection of the events that took place and that she could only go on about what Conway had told her about the event.

The interview concluded at approximately 0525 hours.
