Narrative:

On Wednesday, October 5, 2022 at 1221 hours, Ohio Attorney General's – Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) – Special Agent Charlie Snyder (Snyder) was dispatched initially to an Officer Involved Critical Incident at 2347 Margaret Street, Akron (Springfield Township), Ohio (Summit County) 44312. While in route to assignment, Special Agent Supervisor David Posten (Posten) made cellular contact with Snyder at 1247 hours and redirected Snyder to respond to Summa Systems – Akron Campus (Akron City Hospital), located at 141 Forge Street, Akron, Ohio 44304, where party from incident scene had been taken.

At approximately 1330 hours, after arrival at Summa Systems – Akron Campus, Snyder spoke to Emergency Room personnel. Snyder learned the subject was deceased and tentatively identified by hospital personnel to be Joshua McCracken with possible date of birth of March 3, 1984. The decedent had sustained a single ballistic wound to the approximate center anterior highabdominal/lower chest area with no apparent exit wound. Snyder at this time captured three iphone images of the decedent. According to Summa Systems personnel, there had been attempted thoracotomy procedures and no evidentiary items recovered from those efforts from decedent.

Snyder spoke by telephone with Summit County Medical Examiner's - Chief Investigator Garry Guenther, learning that possible autopsy would be conducted on Thursday, October 6, 2022 in the AM hours.

Snyder notified Posten of all learned information and was redirected to now respond to the incident scene for further investigative assistance and follow-up, arriving there at approximately 1358 hours.
