together with present right of way form 20 agreement for removal of buildings. You state that the proposed modified form of agreement will be substituted for present right of way form 20.

Upon examination, it is my opinion that the proposed modified form of agreement is in proper legal form and when properly executed will constitute a valid contract between the parties.

I, therefore, hereby approve the same and am returning the same herewith.
