EASEMENTS—PUBLIC FISHING GROUNDS TO STATE BY DESIGNATED PROPERTY OWNERS, LANDS, GRAND-VIEW TOWNSHIP, WASHINGTON COUNTY.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval certain grants of easement, executed to the State of Ohio by several property owners in Grandview Township, Washington County, Ohio, conveying to the State of Ohio, for the purposes therein stated, certain tracts of land in said township and county.
