Narrative:

On Monday, July 21, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation Special Agent Steven Seitzman received Middletown Police [REDACTED] training records from Deputy Chief Ryan Morgan. SA Seitzman reviewed the records and noted the following:

Range Qualification Records:

[REDACTED] successfully qualified with a Daniel Defense DDM4 patrol rifle on February 12, 2025, receiving a perfect score. On April 23, 2025, he successfully qualified with a Glock 17 duty pistol, also receiving a perfect score.

Subject Control Training

[REDACTED] training records indicate that he has completed various subject control training sessions. Specifically, he has received a TASER certification, de-escalation training, 40-millimeter impact weapon training, and OPOTA use of force training.

Crisis Intervention Training

[REDACTED] has not completed the 40-hour crisis intervention training course to date.

In addition to the records received from the Middletown Police Department, SA Seitzman also obtained [REDACTED] Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy (OPOTA) records via the online OPOTA public records portal.
