APPROVAL—EASEMENT, STATE OF OHIO, THROUGH CON-SERVATION COMMISSIONER, BY PERCY H. HARMON, ET AL., ROADWAY AND PARK PURPOSES, LAWRENCE TOWNSHIP, STARK COUNTY, OHIO.
