Narrative:

On December 5, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Allison Fletcher requested the Portage County Prosecutor's Office to send a subpoena request to the Ravenna Fire Department for a copy of the EMS run report.

On January 21, 2025, SA Fletcher received a copy of the EMS run report from Krista Groves of the Portage County Prosecutor's Office. The report was associated with the October 22, 2024, emergency run by the Ravenna Fire Department (RFD). The patient, Matthew Fries (Fries), was located dead on arrival by EMS personnel. A copy of the run report has been attached to this report.

SA Fletcher reviewed the report and noted the following:

Call # 24-2882

On October 22, 2024, at 11:03:19, Ravenna Fire Department was dispatched to Freedom Street at the Hike and Bike Trail for a stabbing victim later identified as Larry Burghy. While EMS personnel were on scene treating the stabbing victim, police officers were confronted by another subject and "lethal force" was used.

The patient involved in the lethal force/shooting incident was listed as Matt Fries. A narrative provided by the RFD stated Fries was unresponsive when EMS personnel found him lying supine on the Hike and Bike Trail. CPR was attempted but Fries was pronounced dead on scene.


