DEAR SIR:—You have submitted an abstract last continued by H. L. McCafferty, Abstracter, on September 4, 1925, and inquire as to the status of the title of 302.57 acres of land, more or less, adjoining the prison farm at London, Ohio, as disclosed by the abstract.

After an examination, it is my opinion that said abstract shows the title to said lands to be in the name of Warner Harrison, subject to the following encumbrances:
