Narrative:

On October 9, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Nick Valente (Valente) completed a review of the video captured from the body-worn camera (BWC) of [REDACTED] during this incident. [REDACTED] created three separate BWC videos relevant to this investigation and all three videos were reviewed as noted below.

Amped Replay was used to review the videos.

SA Valente made working copies of the three BWC videos and placed the copied videos in a folder on his BCI issued laptop. The working copies of the videos were used for the review.

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The video began as [REDACTED] approached a Tudor style home bearing house number 1556 on an unknown street. [REDACTED] knocked on the door and received no response. [REDACTED] then briefly walked around the property a second time before returning to the front door and knocking again. [REDACTED] again did not receive a response. [REDACTED] returned to his patrol vehicle parked in the roadway and the recording was ended. No frames from this video were bookmarked or saved.

[REDACTED] approached the front door of the subject's home while speaking to the two women. While walking towards the door, [REDACTED] asked, "Is there something going on inside right now?" Genisis replied "yes" and added that her brother had a gun, was 18 years old, and her father was "following him around trying to calm him down." [REDACTED] next asked, "Did he brandish it at anyone?" as he reached the front door. The answer to this question, if provided, was not clearly intelligible on the video. [REDACTED] then asked the two women where their father was. They reported they did not know where in the house their father was and believed he may have been in the basement.

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As [REDACTED] reached for the handle to the front door he stopped and asked the two women, "Does he have the gun in his hand right now?" The two women replied "yes." One of the female voices added, "I don't know if you want to go in there right now. I'm not gonna lie."

[REDACTED] did not enter the home. Rather, he temporarily stood on the front porch/ entryway step as a second officer approached on foot. [REDACTED] requested additional police officers respond to the scene and relayed the information provided to him by the two women over his police radio.

The second officer, known to be [REDACTED], began to ask Genisis follow up questions about where her brother and father were located. Genisis again replied she was not sure of her father and brother's current location.

[REDACTED] requested that Genisis attempt to call her father.

[REDACTED] asked Genisis if the subject was "threatening to harm himself or others." Genisis replied, "I have no idea. I was sleep. I was about to go to sleep. I have school in the morning. So, I just woke up to people yelling." The remainder of her response was drowned out by another voice stating to an officer to go around to the back of the home.

Genisis told the officers she last saw her brother and father as they were going downstairs. She also added that the home had a back door and porch door. When asked, she told the officers that her brother's name was Christian.

[REDACTED] asked, "What is this over?" Genisis replied, "I have no idea. I was in the bed about to go to sleep, and I just hear a gun pop and then I." [REDACTED] interrupted to ask, "You heard it fire?" Genisis replied, "Yeah, and I ran out my room and I saw my sister. You know, she look like, she look like she was in tears. So, I'm like what's going on?" [REDACTED] then suggested the group move away from the front door of the home. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] he was going to get his rifle.

[REDACTED] and Genisis began to walk away from the front door of the home and towards the road where Jacquelyn was already standing. As they walked away from the front door, [REDACTED] again asked Genisis to explain what was going on. Genisis replied that she did not really know and told the officers again that as she was lying in bed, she heard a gun fire. She then saw her sister come down from the attic. She next heard her dad and brother arguing. She heard her dad tell her brother to take his finger off the trigger. Her father then yelled her name and her sister's name and told them to get out of the house. The two women then exited the home.

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Genisis reported that her father telling them to leave seemed to make her brother "even more upset" and the subject questioned why he would shoot his sister. Genisis then said, "And then he started coming towards me."

After having already told [REDACTED] her brother had fired a gun in the house, was upset, Genisis began making the statement "And then he started coming towards me around this frame."

Genisis told [REDACTED] once her brother started to approach her, her father pushed her brother downstairs. The two men then began arguing in the basement. [REDACTED] then interrupted Genisis to yell at Jacquelyn to come toward him at the edge of the property and away from the sidewalk directly in front of the home.

Jacquelyn informed officers that her father and brother had been arguing earlier in the day. Further, before the shooting occurred, the subject had been coming up and down the stairs to the attic and "pulsing."

██████████ walked away from the conversation as Officer Ondercin spoke further with the subject's sisters. ██████████ took a position near the northwest corner of the subject's home near the property line with the neighboring property.

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Genesis was then able to reach her father via telephone. ██████████ attempted to speak with the subject's father, Ferrel. The audio quality of the conversation was poor. It appeared Ferrel could not hear ██████████, who asked Ferrel to exit the home.

██████████ reported it sounded like Ferrel's phone was on speaker and stated it sounded like he heard screaming coming from the phone. Further it sounded like Ferrel said, "Take your finger off the trigger" and "Drop the gun." Moments later the phone was hung up from Ferrel's end.

Around the 10:33 mark of the recording, Ferrel came to the front door and told officers he would not leave his son alone in the home as officers pleaded with him to exit the home. Genesis also joined the officers in trying to convince Ferrel to come outside. Ferrel could then be heard pleading with his son to put the gun down and telling the subject that no one else was in the house.

Various officers could be heard in the following frames giving the subject additional orders to show them his hands. [REDACTED] then approached the subject. As [REDACTED] and other officers approached the subject, apparent blood was visible on the walkway and driveway appearing to lead to the subject.


