Narrative:

On Wednesday, May 20, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) David Hammond (SA Hammond) received requested records and recordings from Bucyrus Police Department (BPD), Richland County Sheriff's Office (RCSO) and Crawford County Sheriff's Office (CCSO). SA Hammond had previously requested all dispatch records, audio recordings (radio, 911, and phone), mobile data terminal (MDT) communications, and any other dispatch/communications-related information for the Officer Involved Critical Incident that occurred on May 10th and 11th, 2026, at 905 E. Warren St. in Bucyrus, Ohio. As a result of that request, the following items were received and reviewed:

The listed entries do not include all of the entries documented in the recording. Rather, the information listed was deemed by the author to be the most relevant and useful in obtaining an understanding of the incident.

00:14:20	There's a closet in the bathroom on the second floor. Just be advised there's a rifle in that closet. It looks like the room that they believe he's in. The door's cracked but it's closed. We can't see inside of it, and the light is on in that room. The lights are off in the rest of the house. There's also a surveillance camera on the second floor that's facing the stairs and the room that he's possibly in.

At the 00:32 mark, "Please make sure, like we're not trying to cause a scene or anything and I don't want them to know it's us or anything, but there's an alley behind our house and like I said, we have a little fire out back right now, so they'll see us."

The date of the call was listed as Sunday, May 10th, 2026, at 23:41:58 hours. 911 dispatch requests the location of the emergency. The male caller advised the following:

At the 00:21 mark, *"It's at my home. I got some tyrannical terrorist fucks with weapons at my house."*

At the 00:30 mark, *"Got some tyrannical terrorist fucks from my tyrannical government agency, uh, known as the Bucyrus Police Department with weapons. I, I feel so insecure."*

The dispatcher asked the caller his name.

At the 00:46 mark, *"My name is Paul. We'll just leave it at that."*

The dispatcher advised that she was preparing to transfer the call to the Bucyrus Police Department.

At the 00:55 mark, *"They're, known as tyrants. It sucks. Can I get like the FBI? Gimme the CIA, uh, actually, transfer me to Trump. I know him personally."*

The dispatcher notified the caller that his call was being transferred to the Bucyrus Police Department.

At the 01:20 mark, *"They're tyrants, they're liars. I need to get beyond that."*

At the 01:30 mark, *"At this point in time, the Constitution service stays when they come constructive against people that supposedly do the, I, it's my right to fight or alter and that shit. And, uh, I didn't do nothing wrong. Supposedly, knock on my door and I did nothing wrong. And, uh, at my door threatening me with weapons. So, I'm in like, uh, rock and a hard place. I need some fucking, can he get Dorsey on the phone?"*

The dispatcher advised that she would transfer the caller to Eastside to be connected.
A second dispatcher answered.

At the 02:20 mark, *"I got a bunch of tyrants on my fucking door threatening me with weapons."*

At the 02:30 mark, *"Can you transfer me to the FBI agent Andrews or can you transfer me to the CIA Andrew, Nick, uh, or if not, transfer me to Trump perfectly please."*

The dispatcher advised that she doesn't have the numbers that he has requested.

At the 02:44 mark, *"There's a bunch of tyrannical fucks on my porch threatening me with weapons and they put me in a defense to where I defend myself. I don't want to do that. I don't want, I, I got seven fucking kids."*

At the 02:57 mark, *"They're in wrong place the wrong time, and I need help. So, Trump, I can give you a cell phone number directly. Fuck."*

The date of the call was listed as Sunday, May 11th, 2026, at 00:45:27 hours. 911 dispatch requested the location of the emergency. The male caller advised the following:

At the 00:22 mark, *"On my property. I got some paid gang member fucks. I'm a federal agent undercover and these fuckers won't stand the fuck down. They're putting me in a situation where I had to stand by cover. Okay. I don't know what the fucking do. My phone is in the car outside. I'm on a company, supposedly paid phone, and I, they're putting me in a situation. I need you to contact Director Andrews and have them stand the fuck down. FBI, Pennsylvania, the division."*

The call was then transferred to the Police Department. 911 dispatch requested the location of the emergency. The male caller advised the following:

At the 01:19 mark, "905 East Warren Street. I'm an undercover fucking federal agent and I got some tyrant fucks on my porch. Harass me and they're about to blow my cover. Okay. I need them to stand down contact address in the Pennsylvania division. I need them to get the fuck off by. They're about to blow a seven-year long investigation."

The call was then transferred to another number after the dispatcher advised that she has that male on 911. The phone call was then disconnected.
