On July 21st, 2022, Special Agent (SA) Kevin Wagner with the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) responded to the Montgomery County Coroner's Office to retrieve evidence from the autopsy of Richard Poulin (Poulin). Poulin had been in a pursuit with the Highland County Sheriff's Office (HCSO), where he eventually was stopped and was struck by a bullet from Sergeant [REDACTED]'s sidearm. Poulin was pronounced deceased at the scene, and was transported to the Montgomery County Coroner's Office for an autopsy.

SA Wagner arrived to the coroner's office where he took custody of the property from Poulin's autopsy. Among the property were the following items;

Evidence #	Evidence Description
1	Envelope containing blood card
2	\$70.00 in cash and three lighters
3	Fingerprints, scrapings, swabs, and hair samples
4	Recovered bullet
5	Hat, boots, socks, underwear, and shorts
6	Blue button up shirt

SA Wagner transported the property back to BCI where item 4 was submitted to the Laboratory for comparison. The remaining items were submitted to the BCI evidence lockers to be put in the major crimes evidence vault.
