### Narrative:

On November 12, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Nick Valente (Valente) completed a review of the video captured from the body-worn camera (BWC) of Shaker Heights Police Officer Rodney Munson (Officer Munson) during this incident.

Amped Replay was used to review the video.

SA Valente made a working copy of the BWC video and placed the copied video in a folder on his BCI issued laptop. The working copy of the video was used for the review.

Activity/Notes	This is the last frame of the video.

The video began as Officer Munson and a fellow officer blocked access to Yellowstone Road at Mayfield Road with their police cruiser. The two officers then walked to the scene. Once Officer Munson reached the general area of the scene, he stood in the roadway for approximately 14 minutes while seemingly awaiting direction from Cleveland Heights Police. While standing in the roadway and speaking with other officers about unrelated topics Officer Munson turned his BWC recording off prior to taking any action beyond blocking the roadway with his cruiser. No derivative works were made from the recording.
