Narrative:

On Sunday, October 12, 2025, at 0801 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Matt Collins (SA Collins) and Columbus Division of Police (CPD) Det. Chris Journey (Det Journey) interviewed Chrissy Alred (Alred), relative to the officer-involved shooting which took place on Sunday, October 12, 2025. The interview took place in the area of 8th St. and High St., Columbus, OH. The purpose of the interview was to obtain all relevant information of the incident known or observed by this individual. During the course of the interview Alred described there to be only one individual in the encounter with police. She described the individual as being light-skinned, with curly hair, light colored top, unknown pants. For clarity, the subject, who was later identified as Ta'Shawn Davis (Davis) will be identified by name. Understanding, Alred does not know this individual.

Alred stated her boyfriend, Chesrae Gravely, lived on 9th St. and the two of them were walking (North) on High St., toward 9th St. Alred said she first became aware of a situation from receiving information on her "citizen notification app." She described somebody's "chains got jacked." Alred said she witnessed five (5) police cruisers go by them. Alred described being on the east side sidewalk, across from the Village Bar. Alred stated she witnessed police telling a subject to stop or stop moving. Alred said she heard Davis say something back to him. Alred described Davis to be "mouthy" but she could not make out what exactly Davis said. Alred was asked again about what she believed Davis was saying. Alred said she could only tell it was something "negative" based on Davis's facial expression. SA Collins asked if it was on the lines of "hey give me a second, or—" Alred stated, "it was aggressive." Alred later said Davis, "screwed his face up angrily." Alred said she heard guys from the Hookah Lounge, "scream, that he had a gun." Alred said she witnessed "them" head towards the stairwell, and she heard "less than 10 shots fired." Alred stated she had turned her back to the officer and Davis, just prior, because she was trying to get out of the area.

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SA Collins clarified with Alred, that she had heard the individuals from the Hookah Lounge say he had a gun. Alred was asked if she had witnessed Davis with a gun and she stated no. Alred stated once she heard that comment, she and her boyfriend were focused on getting out of the area.

Alred was asked if she'd seen anyone else accompanying Davis and she stated no.

The interview concluded at approximately 0810 hours.
