**Narrative:**

On Monday, June 16, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Joseph Lamping (SA Lamping) received a "Firearms Trace Summary" report from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF). The report contained information about the firearm that Lloyd Ray possessed during the incident on June 5, 2025. The report provided details about the .22 long rifle Savage Arms Incorporated model 64 bearing serial number 2843154, [REDACTED]

On Wednesday June 18, 2025, an additional ATF report was received in reference to a .22 long rifle Derya Arms model TM22-A-18 bearing serial number TG970-22A104883. The report indicated that the firearm was purchased by [REDACTED]  
[REDACTED] This firearm was in the residence but was not in Lloyd Ray's direct possession at the time of the incident as it was recovered from a storage area.

Additionally, an FBI National Crime Information Center (NCIC) check of the weapons was conducted by the BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit to determine if the weapon was reported as being stolen. [REDACTED]
