Narrative:

On Tuesday October 29, 2024, Special Agent Supervisor (SAS) Scott Stranahan (Stranahan) and Special Agent (SA) Tiffany Najmulski (Najmulski) went to 748 Longmeadow Lane, Apt. B, Findlay, Ohio, to speak to Calvin Darapheth's (Calvin) mother, Vidakone Inthavong (Vidakone). Agents received information that Calvin had passed away earlier that day. The reason for the visit was to introduce themselves and to advise the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) would be investigating.

The following is a summary of the conversation which was digitally recorded and attached to this report and to the case file.

Agents introduced themselves and advised what the role of the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) was and the process of the investigation. Vidakone expressed that she had not received answers about what really happened and why the police shot her son. SAS Stranahan advised he could not tell her all the details but wanted to say during the processing of the scene that a gun was found that did not belong to the officer.

Vidakone expressed that she wanted to make sure agents obtained phone records and body worn camera footage. She said she had heard rumors about how the incident occurred which made her confused and have more questions. Agents assured Vidakone they would obtain the records and conduct a thorough investigation.

There was no further questions and agents left after giving Vidakone their business cards.

Agents then went to 621 Hillcrest, Findlay, Ohio, to speak with Calvin's father, Thang Darapheth (Thang) and did not receive an answer. Agents left their business cards at the door and as of today's date never received a call. Vidakone advised agents that Thang knows what happened and she is in touch with him.
