Narrative:

On Monday, September 29, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Jesse Bynum (Bynum) and SA Douglas Burke (Burke) compiled background information on Jacob Aaron Derkin (Jacob), a subject involved in the incident on September 18, 2025. The information included researching past police reports involving the subject, searching criminal history records, court records (if applicable), open/closed-source database inquiries, and social media posts. The information gathered was obtained from the BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit (CIU) and the Medina County Sheriff's Office (MCSO), Wadsworth Police Department (WPD) and Brunswick Police Department (BPD).

SA Burke reviewed the information and noted the following from MCSO, WPD, and BPD:

SA Bynum told SA Burke that the only involvement which BPD had with Jacob was the OICI on September 18, 2025. BPD had no prior involvement regarding Jacob prior to the OICI.

SA Burke reviewed MCJ reports which involved Jacob. Jacob was only booked into the MCJ on one (1) occasion for Fleeing and Eluding, which stemmed from a MCSO arrest on June 16, 2007.

Database Searches:

The Criminal Intelligence Unit (CIU) searched various databases for information pertaining to Jacob. Information such as past addresses, phone numbers, and owned property were located on the database. None of the information obtained was immediately relevant to this investigation.

SA Bynum requested the CIU Unit to search for Jacob on social media platforms while completing their workup. Jacob was found to be associated with the following Facebook, LinkedIn, and Email Accounts:

Initial Narrative By Michael Taylor, 10/04/22 02:48

On October 3, 2022 at approximately 1838 hours, deputies responded to a Wadsworth Township residence in reference to a male in mental distress. The male was located and after evaluation, he was transported to the Medina General Hospital. A report was taken.

Supplemental Narrative By Michael Taylor, 10/04/22 02:50

On October 3, 2022 at approximately 1838 hours, Sgt. Turner and I responded to 7510 State Road, Wadsworth Township, Ohio in reference to a suicidal male. As I was nearing the residence, I observed a male, later identified as Jacob Derkin, yelling at his mother, Roellen Sinkewich. Jacob met me within the driveway stated he did not want to live any longer and wanted to die and further admitted to consuming eighteen 30mg trazodone pills which are prescribed to him to help fall asleep.

I asked Jacob why he was in distress. Jacob replied he was severe depression and has been battling a severe brain virus which causes serious pain. Jacob stated he has been battling the virus for years and it is becoming unbearable. He also stated there was peer pressure placed on him from other family members in reference to attending a banquet

for depression. I asked Jacob if he would like to be seen for his mental distress and he accepted the help. I further advised dispatch for the necessity of an ambulance.

I further spoke to Jacob's mother, Roellen Sinkewich. Roellen corroborated Jacob's statement. She further advised Jacob has spoke of suicide in the past, but this is the first time he has acted on it. She also stated she is becoming afraid of Jacob and wants him removed from the home. She was advised of the eviction and protection order processes. I also provided Roellen with pamphlets for suicide prevent and Alternative Paths if she needed any further assistance in helping Jacob.

I followed up with Dr. Michael Bragagnolo of Medina General Hospital. I informed him of Jacob's suicide attempt and asked if he would like me to complete a pink slip. Dr. Bragagnolo stated Jacob wanted to sign himself in voluntarily, however, if he does try to leave they would complete the pink slip instead. Dr. Bragagnolo was advised to call the Medina County Sheriff's Office if he needed any further information.

Initial Narrative By Zachary Kirkwood, 09/26/24 17:12

On September 26, 2024 I was dispatched to Wadsworth Township regarding a suicidal subject who left his residence. The subject was cleared by Alternative Paths, but volunteered to go to the hospital to be evaluated as he was not taking his regularly prescribed medication.

The status of this case is closed, no arrest made.

Supplemental Narrative By Zachary Kirkwood, 09/26/24 17:16

On September 26, 2024 at approximately 1426 hours, I was dispatched to 7510 State Road in Wadsworth Township, regarding a suicidal male. Dispatch advised, Jacob Derkin (Jacob) took himself off of his medication, walked into the woods with only basketball shorts on, and stated he was going to kill himself. I responded with lights and siren. Upon arrival I spoke to the caller, Jacob's mother, Roellen Sinkewich (Roellen).

Roellen advised Jacob was upset due to a misunderstanding regarding their dogs. She stated Jacob became very

angry and left the residence and walked into the woods. She stated Jacob wanted to kill himself. I asked if she believed he would kill himself and she stated yes. Roellen advised Jacob did not have any weapons and did not verbalize a way of causing his own death. While waiting for other Deputies to arrive before checking the woods, myself and Deputy Yorks #141 walked around the back of the residence. While Dep. Yorks searched a storage area around a pool, I saw movement and the color red in the tree line. I approached and called out as I realized it was a person. The subject came out of the woods and identified himself as Jacob.

Jacob wore red basketball shorts, no shirt and no shoes. He allowed me to pat him down for weapons. I did not locate any on his person. Jacob was highly cooperative. I asked Jacob to tell me what happened today. Jacob advised he was upset over his moms misunderstanding of his feeding the dogs. Jacob continued talking, eventually telling a story about a homeless man, meeting Jesus and the devil, and how P Diddy's arrest was the same day he decided to stop taking his medications. I asked Jacob if he wanted to kill himself and he stated no. I asked Jacob if he wanted to or had thoughts of harming himself or anyone else and he stated no. I asked Jacob if he would be willing to speak to Alternative Paths and he agreed. Alternative Paths was forwarded to Dep. Yorks cell phone and I spoke to Jane.

I advised Jane of the situation, and told her that while Jacob appeared manic, he did not appear to be suicidal or homicidal. Jane spoke to Jacob for a few minutes and later advised me he had a forward thinking process and that she scheduled a follow up phone call with him. She stated she did not believe he was suicidal. After speaking to Jane, I spoke to Jacob.

I offered Jacob to go to the hospital on a completely voluntary basis. I advised him that it may be good for him to be evaluated regarding taking himself off of his medications. Jacob agreed to go and was transported to Medina Cleveland Clinic. I dropped Jacob off along with a cell phone and charger, without incident.

Body camera recording has been saved.

A referral has been completed for Alternative Paths.

 Home**Initial Narrative By 01-KRE KEVIN R. ENGLISH, 08/26/01 13:05**

On the above date and time I responded to 7510 State Rd. in reference to an unruly juvenile. Upon arrival I spoke with Ro-ellen Derkin about her son, Jacob Derkin. She advised that Jacob has a temper problem and that he feels he does not have to listen to the rules of the house and that he can speak to her and her fiance any way he wants. Mrs. Derkin advised that on this day she attempted to get Jacob out of bed for church. She advised that this turned into an argument and then became physical. She advised that during the argument Jacob pushed her. She did advise that she was not injured and did not feel threatened. She did not feel that he was intending on harming her. Mrs. Derkin advised that she did not want to have Jacob charged with anything, but did want to know her options for future unruly charges if his behavior continued. I explained that a report would be filed and that she could follow up with the juvenile pros, in the future if she decided to take action.

I then spoke with Jacob Derkin. He advised that he did not want to go to the church that his mother attends. It was later decided that the church issue was just the excuse for today's outburst. I explained to Jacob what his limited options were. When I cleared the residence it appeared that Jacob understood that his poor behavior would no longer be tolerated. No further information at this time.

Initial Narrative By 01-PMS PAUL M. SCHISMENOS, 06/15/02 08:08

On June 15th, 2002, I was advised by dispatch of a possible domestic disturbance at 7131 Northview Dr., in Sharon Twp.. The complainant, Det. Foraker, indicated that a subject was in the yard at 7131 yelling. Wadsworth P.D. and Dep. Seiberling #169 responded to assist. Upon my arrival into the area and being stationary just north of the residence I observed a male subject walk to the tree line just behind the residence and started to apparently urinate. That subject would be later identified as Jacob Derkin. While further waiting I saw another male walk from the rear of the residence, who would be later identified as Thomas Higgins III, and then start towards a black vehicle parked in the driveway. He looked in my direction and quickly turned around and went back behind the house. It appeared as if the subject saw me and then returned to the house.

I then saw movement by several subjects in the residence apparently running about. Wadsworth P.D. arrived at which

time I saw Tom again walk from around the rear of the residence. I then confronted him in the driveway. Tom stated that he just got to the residence approximately 15 minutes earlier and he didn't know of anything occurring. He subsequently changed his story and stated that he did hear Jacob and Zachery G. Valentine (the son of the homeowner) yelling. I then attempted to have Jacob or Zack answer the door.

After numerous attempts Tom stated that he would try but found that the door was locked behind him. Zack was observed in the house by a Wadsworth P.D. officer. He eventually came to the front door where he was first met by a Wadsworth P.D officer. Upon speaking with Zack I detected a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage about person and breath. He had red glossy blood shot eyes and swayed back and forth during the conversation. Zack stated that he was 19 years of age which was later confirmed through leads. He stated that he had not been drinking any alcohol. Zack denied any type of altercation. He stated that Jacob was in the residence and he did not know why he wasn't coming out. Zack gave permission to enter the residence with him to locate. Jacob was found in the basement. Jacob stated that he was 18 yoa which was later checked when ran through leads.

Jacob was chewing a large piece of gum but still had an odor of an alcoholic beverage about his breath and person. Gum wrappers were seen on the kitchen floor where I saw people moving about the residence before signing out. Jacob denied drinking any alcohol. I conducted an HGN on him and observed 4 of 6 clues. He had lack of smooth pursuit and distinct nystagmus at maximum deviation. I then placed Jacob under arrest. Dep. Seiberling placed Jacob in a cruiser. Jacob also denied any type of involvement in a disturbance.

I then conducted the HGN on Zack and observed 6 out of 6 clues. He had lack of smooth pursuit, onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees, and distinct nystagmus at maximum deviation. Zack's speech was slurred and his speech was jumbled up. He was mirandized and then he showed us where he hid their alcohol. He opened a lock bathroom door on the first floor off of the kitchen with a hanger. Under the sink in the cabinet was where they hid it. Inside I located a large opened bottle of Vodka, 5 full and 2 empty (containing a little beer) Bud Light 12 oz beer cans. He stated they started out with just shy of a case. Zack stated that he had about 4 to 5 beers and Jacob had that many and more. The alcohol was confiscated and all parties were placed into cruisers for paperwork. Tom did not appear to have been drinking and had just arrived prior to being confronted. I asked permission to check his car for any alcohol, weapons, or drugs. He provided verbal permission to do so. I followed him to his car at which time he opened the drivers door. I immediately observed a ceramic (multi colored) smoking device on the floor board between the running board and drivers seat. I picked the pipe up and detected a strong odor of burnt marijuana about it. Upon further check of the car nothing else was located. When asked how long he had been smoking he stated "to long".

Tom was cited for possession of drug paraphernalia. Both Zack and Jacob were cited for underage possession / consumption of alcohol (they were 19 and 18 yoa respectively). All parties were released with a summons.

Initial Narrative By Troy Seibert, 10/12/06 00:45

On noted date and time, Dep. Simonton #142, Dep. Mernik #133 and I were dispatched to 7510 State Rd. for a threats of suicide complaint. Initial information was that the suspect/victim, later identified as Jacob Derkin, had left the residence in his orange Ford Mustang. Upon arrival at the residence, the mustang was back at the residence.

I met with the reportee, Joseph Derkin(18 yoa brother to victim), whom advised that the entire family had a large verbal argument and Jacob had made the comment "I can't take it anymore...I just want to end it!" Jacob had then left the residence in his vehicle at a very high rate of speed without his headlights on. Joseph then left the residence driving around attempting to locate Jacob and contacted MCSO for assistance. Joseph later returned home to find that Jacob was already there and had apparently jumped into the swimming pool and was pulled out by a younger sibling. A voluntary written statement was obtained from Joseph.

I then located Jacob in his bathroom leaning against the sink and was obviously upset and distraught. Jacob advised that he just couldn't take it anymore. Jacob advised that he would willingly go the Medina General Hospital for mental evaluation. Jacob dressed and I transported Jacob to MGH.

While en route to MGH, Jacob advised that the argument started over his stepfather blaming him for hanging too many wet clothes on a drying clothes rod and causing it to pull out of the wall. The argument soon consumed all members of the family. Jacob further indicated that while he was upset and was going outside one of the family dogs had gotten outside and ran across the street and was killed by a passing car.

I completed a commit pending mental evaluation(pink slip) on Jacob, once at MGH. Jacob was released to MGH security. At present, case is closed.

Initial Narrative By Jason Seiberling, 06/15/07 01:00

On 15 June 2007 at approximately 2300 hours I was patrolling the area of State Route 18 and State Route 94. I was driving through the SHEETZ parking lot and randomly checked registrations on the vehicles in the lot. Upon driving past a blue in color motorcycle, I checked the registration and noticed that the owner (Jacob A. Derkin) did not have a valid Motorcycle Endorsement. At this time the bike was unattended and at the pumps on the east side of the parking lot. I continued through the lot and checked other vehicles in the area. While doing so I observed a male subject matching the description of Mr. Derkin. I began to turn around in the lot and the motorcycle began to travel through the lot and to the exit onto State Route 94. Once I was behind the vehicle, the rider turned his head and then looked forward again quickly and took off from the parking lot onto State Route 94 at a high rate of speed northbound. I activated my emergency overhead light and began to give chase. I observed that the motorcycle was going at least 90-100 mph (this being based upon the amount of distance covered in a short period of time.) The motorcycle continued Northbound on State Route 94, at this high rate of speed and I was able to keep a visual on the motorcycle that was a distance ahead of me. The motorcycle was not visible when it went through some of the curves near the Highland High / Middle schools. I continued Northbound on State Route 94, once at Wilbur Road, the vehicle was no longer visible. I was able to observe Westbound on Wilbur and did not observe the motorcycle. At the Granger Fire Station I turned around and I

was able to then check eastbound on Wilbur. At this time I advised Sgt. Schmoll I was terminating the pursuit. Shortly after terminating the pursuit I was traveling Southbound on State Route 94 and observed the male (later identified as the owner Jacob Derkin) attempting to pick up the Motorcycle and take it out of the drainage ditch in front of the middle school.

I advised dispatch that the motorcycle had crashed and to start EMS. I approached the driver and he was ordered to the ground. Jacob complied quickly and I asked him if he was injured. Jacob replied that he was not and that I could go ahead and take him to jail. Jacob was advised that he was going to be checked out by the EMS and then if he did not go to the hospital he would then be transported to the Medina County Jail.

While waiting for the EMS to arrive Jacob made comments to the effect that he knew what he had done was "dumb" and he also stated that he ran because he did not have an endorsement for a Motorcycle.

Jacob was treated by EMS and released at the scene. I then took Jacob into custody and transported him to the Medina County Jail.

Jacob was charged with Felony Fleeing and Eluding and booked into the Jail. (This charge based on the nature of the offense. I had activated my lights and Siren to initiate a traffic stop and Mr. Derkin refused / failed to stop, during which time Mr. Derkin, without due regard to his or other motorist safety, passed in a no passing zone to wit 2 motorvehicles travelling in the same direction as he).

I advised Jacob that he was also going to have pending charges of Failure to Control, Traffic Control Device, NO MC Endorsement.

Nothing further at this time. A copy of this report to be sent to the Medina City and County Prosecutor for further review.

On December 22, 2014 I was dispatched to an address on State Road in Sharon Township in reference to a suicidal male who had left the residence.

The male was entered into LEADS for an evaluation at the hospital.

Nothing further.

Supplemental Narrative By David King, 12/23/14 03:06

On December 22, 2014 at approximately 2343 hours, I was dispatched to 7510 State Road in Sharon Township in reference to a suicidal male.

Upon arrival, Sgt. English and I met with Ro-Ellen Derkin and Joseph Derkin. They advised their son, Jacob Derkin has made threats of suicide. Today at approximately 1800 hours, Jacob left the residence. Before he left, he told them that

they don't need him and that he doesn't need his family. He told them that they don't care about him. He told them "I hope your God can save me."

Jacob also sent a text to Ro-Ellen saying how he watched a movie of a girl being raped and instead of being sad, he laughed at it. Jacob said he was also thinking about murder, but didn't say he wanted to murder someone. Just after midnight, he sent his mother a text saying "happy birthday" because her birthday is on December 23, 2014. Jacob's cellular phone is through Verizon Wireless and his phone number is 440-823-2688.

Ro-Ellen said Jacob is on anti-depressants and Adderal. She said sometimes he takes the medication and usually abuses them. She believes he is off the medication now. Ro-Ellen advised he is bi-polar and manic depressant. She believes that Jacob is close to breaking down. Ro-Ellen deals with this in her occupation and knows about this behavior. She said Jacob is very withdrawn and usually don't leave the residence. She said he has isolated himself from friends. In the past, Jacob had a motorcycle accident and University Hospitals thought he may have had a tumor on his brain but that was not officially determined. Ro-Ellen was asked when Jacob's last "good day" was and she said Sunday night but its never a whole day. Ro-Ellen said she does fear that Jacob will kill himself.

I had dispatch send out a Bolo to all police agencies in Medina, Summit and Wayne counties advising this.

We asked where Jacob may have went. They advised it would most likely be a parking lot where it is open. She said either a Wal Mart or a church parking lot. She said their church is Northside Christian Church. She said that Jacob left in a 2002 Ford Taurus (276YFT)

I had dispatch contact verizon to ping Jacob's cellular phone. Sgt. English and I checked the area. We checked the churches in the area. Wadsworth PD checked their city for the vehicle. I checked the area of Riverstyx, and the businesses on SR 18. Later, dispatch advised Jacob's phone was pinged in the area of Boneta Road and Osage Trail. We checked that area. We were unable to locate Jacob or the vehicle. Just after 0200 hours, I checked the residence for the Taurus and did not locate it. I checked the Wal Mart parking lot in Wadsworth, church parking lots and area businesses. As of 0300, Jacob has not been located.

Jacob was entered into LEADS to have his welfare checked and to see if he needs an evaluation at the hospital.

I have nothing further at this time.


