Narrative:

On Thursday, March 05, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) John Tingley (SA Tingley) received and reviewed documents from the Parma Police Department (PPD). The records which were requested included any reports pertaining to the February 24, 2026, officer-involved critical incident, except for any statements made by the involved officers. SA Tingley reviewed the documents and noted the following:

The incident number for the report is listed as [REDACTED] and lists an address of 5433 Knollwood Drive, Apartment 8, Parma, Ohio, 44130. The offense description is listed as "Mental Health Crisis" and listed Ricardo Yuuki Davis (Davis) as the subject and Henry Daniel Siekaniec as the person who initially called the PPD. The times documented on the report are listed in the table below:

Where indicated, the following excerpts are taken directly from the narrative section of the PPD report, but do not include all of the information contained in the narrative section. Rather, the excerpts and other notations only include the information deemed by the author to be the most relevant and useful in obtaining an understanding of the PPD Incident Report as it relates to the OICI.

As we entered the apartment building and responded to the third floor (apartment 8), we observed two papers taped to the outside of Ricardo's door. [REDACTED] and I read the papers and it appeared to display suicidal rhetoric and ideations.

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Officers then knocked on the door but received no answer. At that time, Officers made the decision to enter the apartment and check on Davis' wellbeing.

Approximately 2-3 minutes later maintenance arrived on scene and [REDACTED] and I entered the apartment...Ricardo was not located inside the apartment, but I observed several alarming things throughout the apartment. I observed several boxes throughout the apartment that were packed with personal property. The boxes with the property were marked and labeled with people's names as if Ricardo intended to give these items to those people.

Inside of the apartment, the Officers also located Davis' car title, a computer (with a note with the password taped to it), several other notes, and a receipt for a Taurus firearm

After discovering the above-mentioned notes and property [REDACTED] and I became extremely concerned for Ricardo's welfare and requested a BOLO be broadcasted to surrounding cities and advising that he may be in possession of a firearm and possibly suicidal."

"I asked Parma police dispatch to conduct a triangulation (ping) of Ricardo's phone in an attempt to locate him."

"Parma police dispatch then updated officers that the phone was now pinging in the 9800 block of Brookpark Road. Parma Police officers the responded to the area and located the vehicle. A traffic stop was conducted on the 2015 Toyota Corolla. During this traffic stop, an officer involved shooting occurred.

On February 24th, 2026 at approximately 1248 hours [REDACTED] and I (Officer James Mack) responded to 5433 Knollwood Drive (#8) to check to welfare of a male. Parma police dispatch advised us that they received a call from PRP (Henry Siekaniec) requesting officers to check the welfare of his friend, Subject (Ricardo Davis). Henry further advised Parma police dispatch that he received a text message from Ricardo that read "Goodbye".

As I was traveling to Ricardo's apartment, I called Henry to gather more information. During this phone call to Henry, he advised me that he has not spoken to Ricardo in a few months. Henry further advised that Ricardo has been depressed in the past, due to not having a job and a girlfriend. Henry further advised me that Ricardo has attempted suicide in the past and he is a concealed carry weapon (CCW) holder, but unknown if he has firearms.

Upon my arrival onto Knollwood Drive I advised [REDACTED] of the information I received from Henry. As we entered the apartment building and responded to the third floor (apartment #8), we observed two papers taped to the outside of Ricardo's door. [REDACTED] and I read the papers and it appeared to display suicidal rhetoric and ideations. [REDACTED] knocked on the closed locked door several times with no response [REDACTED] and I became extremely concerned for Ricardo's welfare, due to the nature of the call, conversation with Henry and the notes found on his door. After knocking for several minutes and not receiving a response, I asked for Knollwood property maintenance to respond with a key to check on Ricardo. Approximately 2-3 minutes later maintenance arrived on scene and [REDACTED] and I entered the apartment. [REDACTED] and I announced our presence as police officers as we safely checked the apartment for Ricardo. Ricardo was not located inside the apartment, but I observed several alarming things throughout the apartment. I observed several boxes throughout the apartment that were packed with personal property. The boxes with the property were marked and labeled with peoples names as if Ricardo intended to give these items to those people. I also observed in the living room area a large desk and table. On the desk was a computer with a note tape to it, which appeared to have several passwords and log in credentials. The title to Ricardo's 2015 Toyota Corolla and several other concerning notes on the table. In plain-view on the table there was two receipts from the Parma Armory. Further inspection of the receipts uncovered the purchase of a Taurus firearm in October of 2025. I also observed a chair directly behind the only entrance/exit door of the apartment. The door appeared to be in an odd place, as if someone was waiting or sitting directly behind the door. After discovering the above mentioned notes and property [REDACTED] and I became extremely concerned for Ricardo's welfare and requested a BOLO be broadcasted to surrounding cites and advising that he may be in possession of a firearm and possibly suicidal. We also checked the parking lot for Ricardo's Toyota Corolla which was not there. I asked Parma police dispatch to conduct a triangulation (ping) of Ricardo's phone in an attempt to locate him. While waiting for the triangulation of Ricardo's phone, [REDACTED] left the apartment to check the area and I remained inside the apartment.

Parma Police dispatch advised that they received a triangulation from Ricardo's phone and it was in the area of James Hanna Park (11212 Snow Road Parma, Ohio 44130). Several Parma Police officers began checking the area, but could not locate Ricardo. Parma police dispatch then updated officers that the phone was now pinging in the area 9800 block of Brookpark Road. Parma Police officers the responded to the area and located the vehicle. A traffic stop was conducted on the 2015 Toyota Corolla. During this traffic stop an officer involved shooting occurred
