Narrative:

On May 27, 2025, at 1045 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agents Lauren Frazier and Douglas Eveslage interviewed Mike Dunn, the son of Mary Dunn. Also present was Mike's wife, Meygan Dunn. The interview took place outside near 909 Garden Avenue in Middletown, Ohio. The purpose of the interview was to speak with family of Mary Dunn and to obtain all relevant information regarding the incident.

The following summary of the recorded interview highlights the key points that the author deemed most relevant, although it does not provide a verbatim account. Additionally, this report was placed in a chronology to enhance the reader's understanding of the information elicited during the interview. However, it is important to note that this may not reflect the actual order of the questions posed. Therefore, it is suggested that the full audio recording be reviewed.

Mike stated that this morning he saw a news article posted on Facebook by Fox 19 News about people having been shot on Garden Avenue. He said that they knew that Mary lived in the area, so they came to check on her. Meygan said that Mary has lived on Garden Avenue since December of 2024. Mike said that he hasn't spoken to his mom in some time. He said that since she has moved to this area, they have not talked frequently.

Mike and Meygan were unsure of Michael Baker and Mary's relationship. Mike said that Mary has bounced around with roommates that are males, whether they're in relationships or not. Meygan said that they hang out together and live together, but they don't really say that they're in a relationship. Mike said that Mary is on disability and does not work. She also does not own a vehicle.

Agents advised Mike and Meygan that Mary had been shot in her leg during the officer-involved incident that happened this morning. They were advised that she was transported to Atrium Hospital for medical attention. Meygan said that they tried calling there earlier but were not given any information.

Mike was not aware of any drug-related activity involving his mother or Michael Baker. Mike owns Dunn's Tire Service and said that he met Michael Baker around 2015, when he was a customer. He said that Michael was not aggressive and it was a surprise when him and Mary got together. They were unsure how Michael and Mary met.

The interview concluded at 1057 hours. The interview was audio recorded and is attached to this report.
