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Sir:

On Monday, May 30, 2022 while at my private residence, I received a FIT call up at 0458 hours. I contacted my immediate supervisor, Sgt. Rini #9051, to acknowledge that the call up had been received. I learned from Sgt. Rini that I was to respond to University Hospital Emergency Room for processing and that the male involved had died. I arrived at University Hospital at 0641 hours and met with Homicide Unit Det. Schultz #508. I learned that the deceased male had been shot one time and that his clothes had been taken off by hospital staff. Below are the results of this scene process.



On Scene: Homicide Unit (Det. Schultz # 508), 4B37 (Bloxtton #32, Hannewald #365), Internal Affairs Unit (Sgt. Ilain #9239), FBI (S.A. Andy Burke), University Hospital Staff Mortician (Shawn Reilly)

Scene: This is an indoor scene consisting of CDU Room #9 in the University Hospital Emergency Department.

Photos: CS# 177690+B, 40 photos were taken showing the overall views of now identified black male, Datwuan Catchings, laying on his back naked in an opened body bag on a hospital bed in CDU Room #9. Photos show an intraosseous infusion port in Catchings left leg below his knee. Photos show Catchings right hand bagged and the left hand with the bag taken off for identification purposes. Photos show a hospital medical band around Catchings left ankle with generic information as Catchings was unidentified when he was brought into the hospital. Photos show one defect in center, left side of Catchings back at about elbow level. Photos show the body bag sealed with Catchings inside with another generic identification tag connecting the zippers of the bag.

Photos show a blue plastic bag with a chain of custody form taped to it. Photos show three sealed brown paper bags inside of the blue plastic bag which contained Catchings clothes and personal effects. Photos show these bags opened and the contents of each bag.


- 1 pair of red boxer shorts underwear with suspected blood recovered from the blue plastic bag. (112/30)
- 1 pair of multiple color ankle socks with suspected blood recovered from the blue plastic bag. (112/31)
- 1 pair of black shorts with suspected blood recovered from the blue plastic bag. (112/32)
\$85.00 in 4 20s and 1 5, with suspected blood recovered from the black shorts the blue plastic bag. (112/33)
- 1 unopened package of 2 cigars, 1 cigarette lighter, 1 vape cartridge and 1 unopened condom with suspected blood recovered from the black shorts the blue plastic bag. (112/34)
- 1 blue plastic bag with a chain of custody sheet which contained Catchings clothing and personal effects. (112/35)

Summary: On May 30, 2022, I responded to University Hospital located at 11100 Euclid Ave. for a +B crime scene process. I met and conferred with Homicide Det. Schultz and this scene was processed as documented above. LERMS entries have been completed.
