APPROVAL—TWO GRANTS OF EASEMENT EXECUTED TO THE STATE OF OHIO BY OWNERS IN ALLEN AND PUTNAM COUNTIES, OHIO FOR USE AS PUBLIC FISHING GROUNDS.

DEAR SIR: You have submitted for my examination and approval two certain grants of easement, together with the proper court pleadings, executed to the State of Ohio by property owners in Allen and Putnam Counties, Ohio, conveying to the State of Ohio, for the purposes therein stated, certain tracts of land.

The grants of easement here in question, designated with respect to the number of the instrument, location of the land by township and county, and the name of the grantor, are as follows:
