By the provisions of the lease here in question, there is leased and demised to the lessee above named, for a term of fifteen years and for an annual rental of one hundred dollars, the right to use and occupy for cottage site, business and docklanding purposes, the inner slope and water front and the outer slope and borrow pit adjacent thereto that is included in Embankment Lot No. 58, east of Sayre's boathouse at Buckeye Lake, and being part of the southwest quarter of section 14, and part of the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section 13, town 17, range 18, Licking County, Ohio.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by the state of Ohio by the hand of the conservation commissioner and by the lessee above named.
