Narrative:

On October 12th, 2025, the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) was requested by the City of Columbus Police Department (CPD) to investigate an officer involved critical incident. As part of the investigation, Special Agent Doug Eveslage responded to the Grant Medical Center at the above-mentioned address collecting Tashawn Marrice Davis' clothing.

SA Eveslage arrived at the hospital at approximately 0740 hours. A Grant Medical Center Security Guard escorted SA Eveslage to the morgue in the basement where he met CPD Officer Moore. Ofc. Moore advised that CPD attempted to identify the now identified suspect, Tashawn Marrice Davis, by fingerprinting two of his fingers from his right hand but were unsuccessful. Ofc. Moore opened the refrigerator and identified Davis's body. SA Eveslage collected the brown paper bag of Davis's belongings that were removed by hospital personnel and placed into a paper bag only identified by a generic intake number, MRN: [REDACTED], due to Davis not being identified yet. The paper bag only contained one pair of white tube socks and a small dark colored piece of cloth, believed to be for hair.

SA Eveslage spoke to the emergency room Charge Nurse and several other personnel attempting to locate any additional clothing or personal belongings and also helped search the trauma bay that Davis occupied; however, no other items were located.

SA Eveslage transferred Davis's property to Crime Scene Special Agent David Hammond at approximately 0815 hours for further processing.
