Narrative:

On July 17, 2022, at 0900 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agents Kenneth Smith (SA Smith) and Steven Seitzman (SA Seitzman), observed the autopsy of Richard Poulin (Poulin) at the Montgomery County Coroner's Office, 361 W. Third Street, Dayton, Ohio. Poulin was part of an Officer-Involved Critical Incident (OICI) that occurred with the Highland County Sheriff's Office on July 17, 2022, in the roadway on US 62, Hillsboro, Ohio.

Bryan Casto, M.D., conducted the autopsy of Poulin. [REDACTED]

The autopsy was concluded at approximately 1115 hours. Dr. Casto advised all evidence collected during the autopsy would be secured at the Montgomery County Coroner's Office until BCI Special Agents take custody of the items, he also advised the autopsy report and photographs would be available at a later date.
