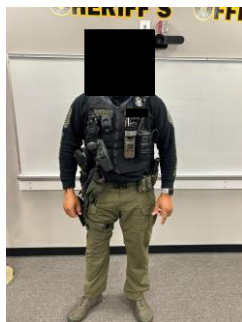

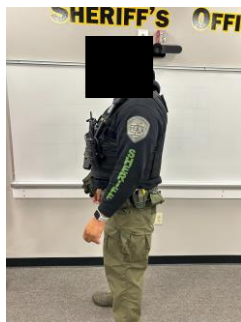

in TCSO's roll-call room.

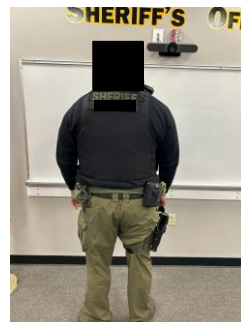
