**Narrative:**

On Monday, December 12, 2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) John Tingley reviewed the records forwarded to him by the Delaware County Sheriff's Office (DCSO) and the Mansfield Police Department (MPD) regarding the cost of the repairs of the damage to the respective armored tactical vehicles incurred on August 20, 2022, in Knox County, Ohio, related to the officer-involved critical incident.

DCSO Captain Vance forwarded a copy of the letter from the Marysville Police Department, which listed the damage and the cost of repairs to the MPD BATT armored vehicle (which was being utilized by the Delaware Tactical Unit). These costs included: a seven-ton jack stand; a tow bill from Hogan Tire; windshield replacement (two windows); tire replacements; run flat replacement; and costs associated with a round trip to Dearborn, Michigan, for repairs. These costs totaled \$25,228.70.

MPD Chief Porch and MPD Sergeant Lumadue forwarded emails and a tow bill from the MPD, which listed the damage and the cost of the repairs to the MPD Bearcat armored vehicle. These costs included: six tires; right front brake hose; section of the lower radiator hose; and a tow bill from Shelly Smith and Sons towing. These costs totaled \$4580.77.
