#### Narrative:

On Sunday, December 8, 2024, at 1552 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent Eric Lehnhart (SA Lehnhart) received a voice mail from Sergeant Aaron Bushey of the Shelby Police Department. Sergeant Bushey called to request the return of personal property that belonged to Shelby Police Officer Noah Kocher. This property was assumed to have been in Officer Kocher's uniform pants at the time of the incident and was transferred to BCI with other items believed to have had evidentiary value.

SA Lehnhart traveled to the BCI Richfield Northeast Regional Office and located a brown paper bag that contained Officer Kocher's uniform in temporary locker #40. On further examination, SA Lehnhart located the following personal property in Officer Kocher's uniform pants pocket.

- Black Wallet
- · Keys on Ohio Army Guard Lanyard
- Breeze Pro Vape Pen
- ZYN Spearmint Nicotine Pouches
